

Department 7H Horses – Youth

1. Junior Horse Show:

- A. Entry forms and Coggins must be completed on each animal and returned by date posted in Calendar to the County Extension Office or uploaded on the Fair website.
- B. Exhibitors are limited to no more than 2 entries in one class.
- C. Exhibitors may get help when 2 animals fall into the same class.
- D. All horses will show by halter.
- E. No stallions will be shown.
- F. The Fair reserves the right to make changes if necessary.
- G. Awards: 1st - \$65 2nd - \$55 3rd - \$45 4th - \$35 5th - \$25 All others - \$15
Best of Show - Rosette Reserve Best of Show - Rosette

2. Junior Horse Showmanship:

- A. Each contestant must show his or her own horse.
- B. Contestants shall not be older than 18 years of age.
- C. Contestants will be divided into four age classes.
- D. Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each class; no cash awards.

3. In-Hand Trail

- A. Two divisions: Junior and Senior.
- B. Number of obstacles will be limited to fit the arena.
- C. Two refusals and you will be asked to go on.
- D. Awards: 1st - \$65 2nd - \$55 3rd - \$45 4th - \$35 5th - \$25 All others - \$15
