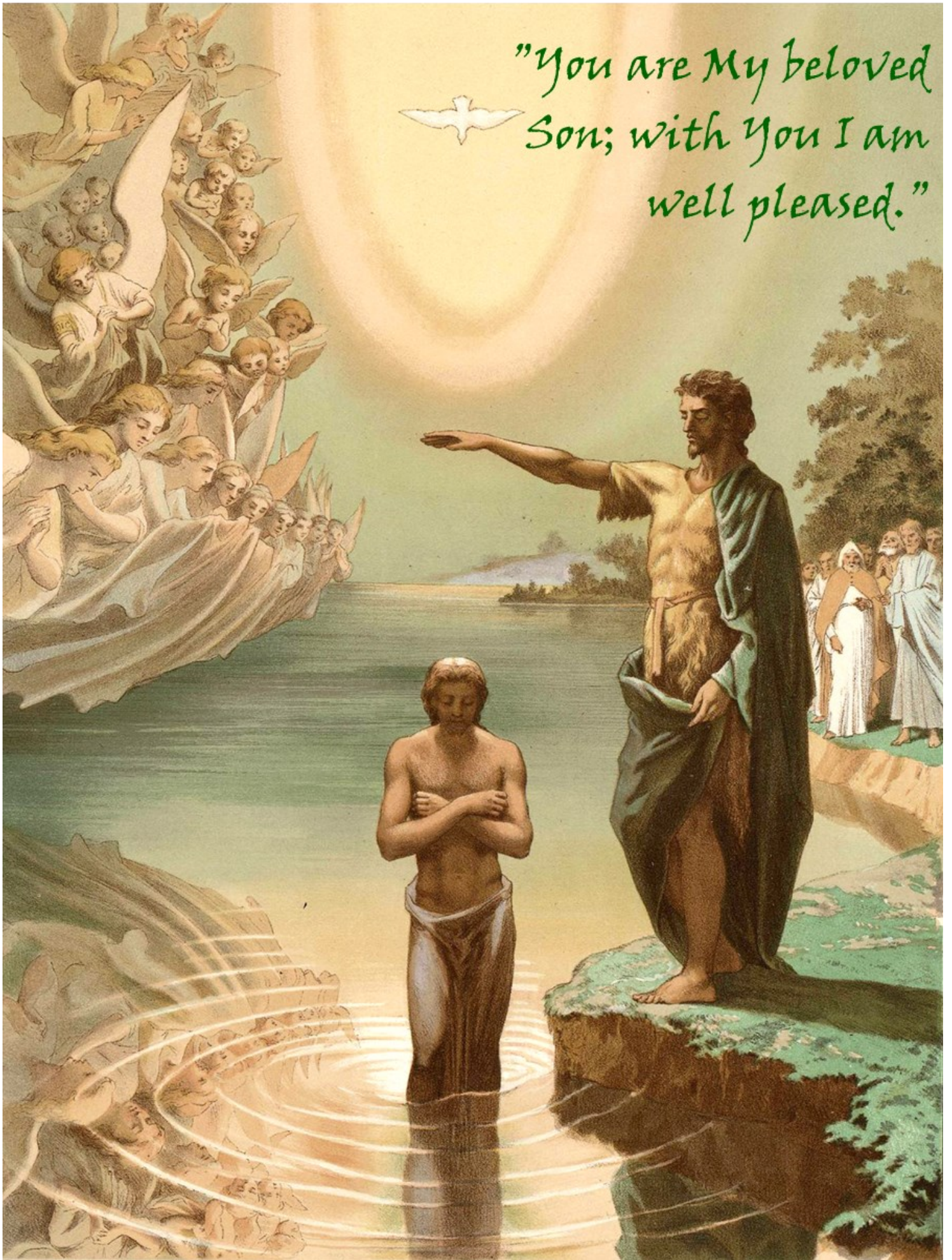

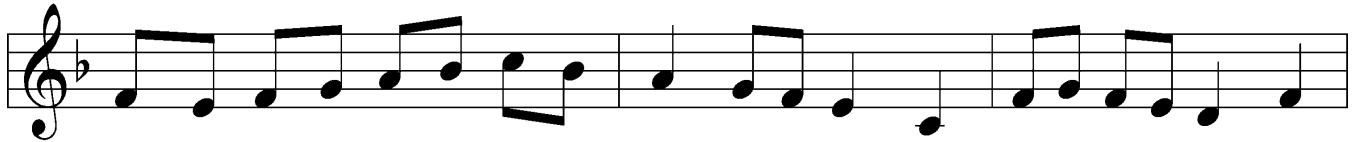
About the Cover
