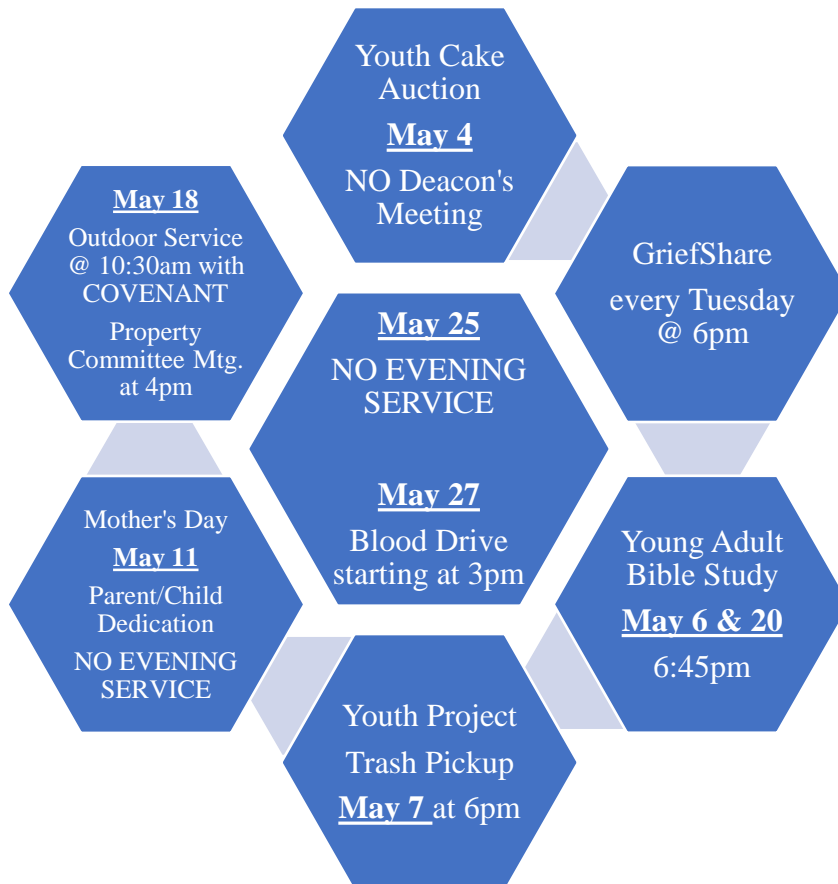

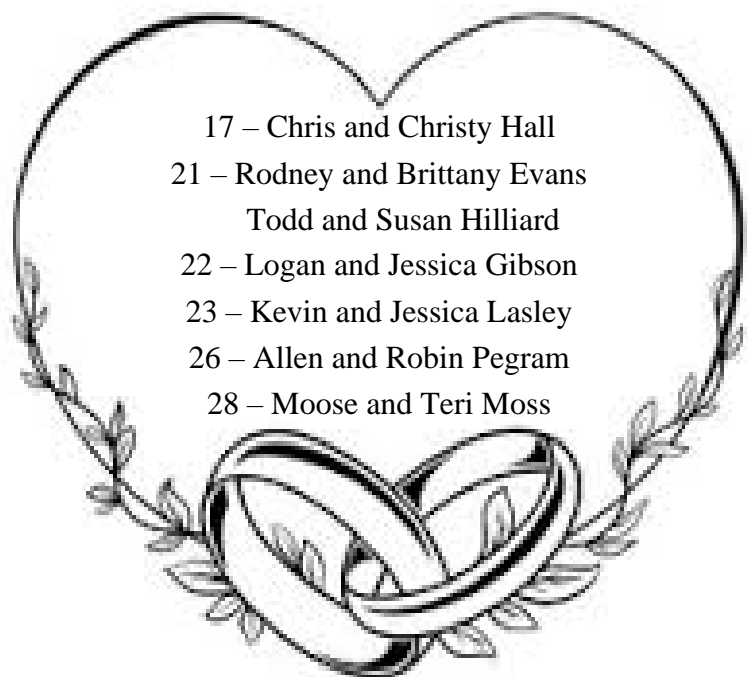

“Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father’s will. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.” – Jesus, **Matthew 10:29-31**

Recently I made a purchase, and I am not yet sure if I am going to like it. I bought a “smart watch.”

Now this is not a fancy Apple watch, but a cheap knock-off that I found on Amazon. Still, it is quite amazing what it will do. This “watch” reads my blood-oxygen level (whatever exactly that is), it can take and tell me my blood pressure, it can tell me if I had good quality sleep or not (though I can usually tell that myself), it keeps track of how many steps I take and how many calories I burn (trust me, not nearly enough), plus various other things it can do that I have not figured out yet, and on top of all that – it even tells me the date and time of day!
