

July 21, 2024 - New Member John Gasper has offered his restoration business for our July meeting. Maggie will confirm this on Monday. We will need to bring our own tables and chairs to this meeting. Charlie will speak with Harold about the chairs he uses.

September meeting: Harold will check with Steve Dearborn about having a meeting there.

November meeting: Annual Thanksgiving dinner meeting at Haul of Fame Museum, date to be announced.

4. Don reminded Members of the **National Show and Convention to be held in York, PA on June 6 - 8, 2024.**

OTHER BUSINESS

1. Cares & Concerns: George Fiebe is still having medical issues.
2. Don reminded members about the Rhode Island Show on June 2, and the ATCA Bethlehem Show on June 8 & 9. We are urged to support fellow antique truck clubs and hope they will do the same.

Arnold & Debby Briggs, Peter Yeomans and his son, Tom Voccola, Chico Aragi, Joanne Rooney and Don and Kathy will be in York. 




