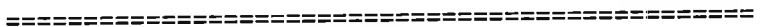

NEW BUSINESS:

Chris Merz addressed the Commission about the TDEC grant. This is to upgrade existing water lines. He requested that Lincoln County represented by the County Mayor execute and submit an application for funds to TDEC in the amount of \$4,570,687.89 to be used for an asset management plan and water system improvements as allowed by the TDEC ARP grant guidelines. The mayor should be authorized and directed to enter into all necessary agreements to receive and administer such grant funds. The total project cost is \$5,713,359.86. The local matching portion of \$1,142,671.97 or 25% will be provided by funds from Lincoln County Board of Public Utility's General Fund.
