THE ATTORNEY WOULD BE HIRED TO ASSESS OUR CURRENT SITUATION AND PROVIDE LEGAL ADVICE AND OPTIONS ON A WAY FORWARD FOR LINCOLN COUNTY AND ITS CITIZENS.
