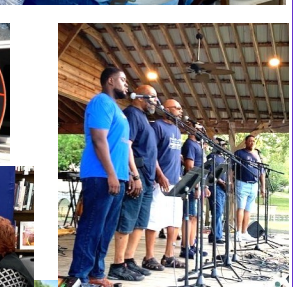
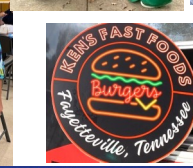

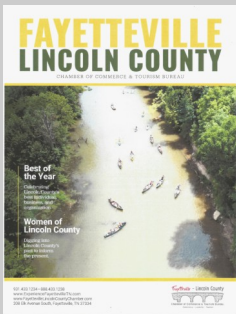
SAB wrapped up 2024 meeting at Dunkin Donuts enjoying a treat from there and playing Dirty Santa.
