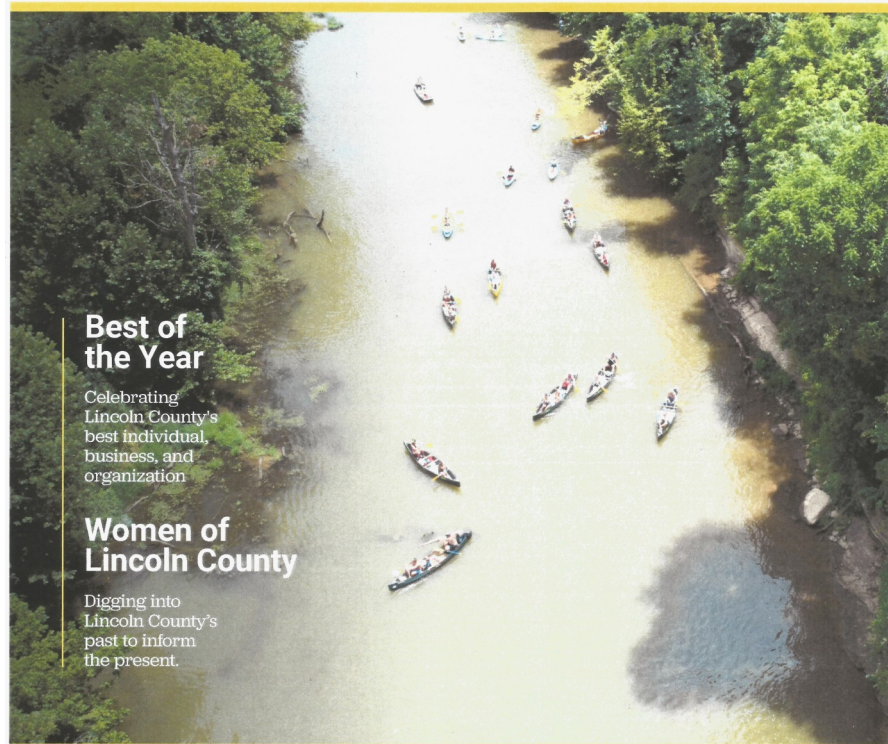
The new edition of the FLC Chamber & Tourism Magazine is available now through Spring of 2025

Education Committee

Meeting Update by Chairman, Lisa Sanders

The May meeting of the Chamber's Education Committee toured the state-of-the-art welding instructional center inside Ariens Co. This program was made possible through a partnership between Fayetteville City High School, Lincoln County High School, and TCAT Shelbyville.

Mr. James Sweeton, the program's instructor elaborated on the TCAT curriculum, providing insights into the comprehensive training and education students receive in the program. During the tour, committee members had the unique opportunity to interact with local dual enrollment students actively participating in the welding program. These interactions allowed the committee to ask questions about the students' hand-on experiences, challenges, and the skills they have acquired. The visit highlighted the significant strides made in enhancing vocational education through strategic partnerships, aiming to equip students with practical skills and improve their employment prospects in the welding industry. The committee left with a deeper understanding of the program's impact on students and the broader community, emphasizing the importance of continued support and development of such education initiatives.
