### **How to Make America Great Again**

It is sign of the times that when people are told that Harvard was founded by a Puritan minister and dedicated to Christ and His Church. most react by wondering if this can actually be true. The reaction is evidence that Cultural Marxism has almost succeeded in eradicating the facts about the Christian roots of American education.

During her 2016 commencement address, however, Harvard President Drew Faust referred to a gathering near Harvard's Memorial Church, one of those "enduring symbols of Harvard's larger identity and purposes, testaments to what universities do and believe at a time when we have never needed them more." She added, "And much is at stake, for us and for the world."

This was an extraordinary statement of historical accuracy. What's more, she went on to tell the graduates that values should be a major influence in their daily lives.

She said, "For this morning's ceremony I wore the traditional Harvard presidential robe—styled on the garment of a Puritan minister and reminding us of Harvard's origins. Values were an integral part of the defining purpose of the early years of Harvard College, created to educate a learned ministry."

It's rarely mentioned these days, but the official website declares that "Memorial Church of Harvard University is a space of grace in the center of the Yard, rooted in the good news of Jesus Christ." In fact, Harvard itself was rooted in that good news.

The real history of Harvard and other colleges is seldom mentioned in the new, modern, and secular America that we have today. But I went to my bookshelf for a copy of Vaughn Shatzer's 1999 book, History of American Education, which tells the almost forgotten story of how Harvard and other colleges, including Princeton, Yale, William and Mary, Rutgers, and even Columbia, were based on a Christian worldview.

The facts in this small, 127-page book are not only important but politically relevant today, as Shatzer devotes a section to Hillary Rodham Clinton's involvement in the federal takeover of America's schools. That effort today is known as Common Core.

Going back in history, Shatzer writes, "Many of our Founding Fathers such as John Adams, John Hancock, Samuel Adams, and Fisher Ames attended Harvard. Amazingly, Fisher Ames, who proposed wording for the First Amendment, entered Harvard at age twelve." "Of the first 126 colleges formed in America," he notes, "all but three were formed on Christian principles. Up until 1900 it was very rare to find a university president who was not an ordained clergyman." Is the pendulum now swinging away from Cultural Marxism and back toward America's founding principles?

It may not be Harvard President Faust's intention to return the American educational system back to its original Christian values. But in order to truly make America great again, the "values" she talks about have to be given their true meaning within the context of American society at large.

She concluded her address by saying, "Reason and responsibility. Widener and Memorial Church. Harvard and the world. We have a very special obligation in a very difficult time. May we and the students we send forth today embrace it.



David was hunted, haunted and harassed. Often he was forced

into a crevice and had little room to move or stretch. But in his moments of oppression he did not seem to suffer from depression. He felt free to sing a song of hope that God planted in his heart. He found a source of strength that came to him from his dearest friend and constant companion - God!

"I will sing of Your strength, in the morning I will sing of Your love; for You are my fortress, my refuge in times of trouble!" wrote David as he reflected on the troubled times of his life. And he was not the only one who found themselves in life threatening and even life ending situations.

Do you remember what Paul and Silas did when they were thrown into prison for serving

the Lord? At midnight they were praying and singing hymns of praise to the Lord while the other prisoners listened to them. God joined in the celebration, sent an earthquake that caused so much shaking that the prisoners' chains fell off and doors flew open. The confines and chains of being in prison could not silence them.

Josephus, the historian, wrote of the Christians awaiting death in the Coliseum. Waiting on the lions to maul and mangle them, they sang songs of joy so loudly that their voices were heard above the roar of the lions and the cheers of the crowd. As they faced the lions that would devour them, God put His song in their mouths, His peace in their hearts and angels to comfort them.





# Soldier's faith: Rare Bible carried at the battle of Bunker Hill has moving inscriptions

A rare Bible from the battle of Bunker Hill will be exhibited at the Museum of the American Revolution when it opens in Philadelphia next year. The recently-acquired King James Bible is inscribed by American soldier Francis Merrifield, who thanks God for sparing his life in the bloody 1775 battle.

The museum confirmed Thursday that it purchased the Bible at a Bonham's auction in New York on April 11. The Bible sold for \$161,000, including the buyer's premium.

"This Bible is one of only two known to exist from the Battle of Bunker Hill, and is an authentic witness to one of the most iconic moments of the Revolutionary War," R. Scott Stephenson, the Museum's vice president of collections, exhibitions, and programming, told FoxNews.com, via email. "It provides an incredible opportunity to showcase the role that religious faith played in sustaining those who were involved in the American Revolution. While historians still passionately discuss and debate this important subject, it doesn't always get a great deal of attention in museums."

The Bible was owned by Francis Merrifield, who was born in Ipswich, Mass. in 1735. A veteran of the French and Indian War, which ran from 1754 to 1763, Merrifield joined the Ipswich militia after the Revolutionary War began in 1775. Merrifield served as

a sergeant in the company of Captain Nathaniel Wade in Colonel Little's regiment at Bunker Hill.

More than 100 American troops were killed and 300 wounded in the battle on June 17, 1775. Merrifield survived heavy fighting during the battle and was one of the last to leave the field, according to the Museum of the American Revolution's Historian and Curator Philip Mead.

Merrifield wrote extensively on the front and back covers of the Bible, thanking God for his survival. On the reverse of the New Testament page, he wrote: "Cambridge, Jun 17 1775. I desire to bless God for his Kind aperince [sic] in delivering me and sparing my life in the late battle fought on Bunker's Hill. I desire to devote this spared life to his Glory and honour. In witness my hand, Francis Merrifield." Below the inscription, Merrifield wrote a poem on his hope for divine grace.

The soldier survived the Revolutionary War. He died in 1814.

Several donors funded the purchase of the rare Bible, the museum told FoxNews.com.

When the new museum opens in spring 2017, the Bible will be displayed in a gallery documenting the 1775-1776 siege of Boston. Other exhibits will include a rare signed and dated New England-made military drum and a large-scale reproduction of John Trumbull's painting "The Death of General Warren at Bunker Hill."

A spokeswoman told FoxNews.com that the museum will announce its specific opening date later this month.

# Woman in burka allegedly attacks Georgia homeowner with American flag

A Georgia homeowner was attacked Tuesday by a woman dressed in a burka armed with the American flag that was in the homeowner's yard, The Smoking Gun reported.

Aisha Ibrahim, 30, allegedly pulled Old Glory out of a mailbox in Lawrenceville, which is outside Atlanta, and "in a threatening manner" swung the flag at the homeowner, the report said. A fight ensued until a neighbor was reportedly able to hold Ibrahim, whose eyes were only visible, until police arrived.

Authorities told FoxNews.com that the fight appeared to be unprovoked.

The alleged victim was identified as Dami Arno, who reportedly called for hate-crime charges against Ibrahim.

"A Muslim women tore my flag pole down this morning and attacked me and my daughter with it. After the fight she was charged with simple battery 2 counts, nothing else. No hate crime, no destruction of property, no criminal trespassing -- nothing," Arno reportedly posted on Facebook.

Capt. Tim Wallis, from the Lawerenceville Police Department, said he is going to look into a hate crime charge.

### **Peach Balsamic Chicken Skillet**


