

Georgia school district hiring 450 teachers, no education degree required Staff reports that Savannah-Chatham schools are feeling the hurt of a growing problem nationwide. So right now, Savannah-Chatham schools are holding up the help wanted sign—with 450 openings. To make sure they get those positions filled, the district is using a new program called Alternative Pathways to Teaching. (Ga Trend)

Georgia growth super-concentrated in Atlanta; half state's counties are losing population

Lee Shearer reports that population growth in Georgia has resumed after slumping during the recession, but the pattern of that growth has markedly changed. Metro Atlanta has for years been a magnet for people migrating into the state; from 1990 to 2010, Atlanta's population grew from about 2.6 million to 4.1 million people, according to the Atlanta Regional Commission. Funding approved for reactor design for new subs

Gordon Jackson reports that funding for the design and development of the nuclear reactors for the replacement fleet of ballistic missile submarines has been approved by the U.S. House of Representatives. The 2017 Defense Appropriations Bill includes \$1.48 billion for the design of the reactors that will power the replacement fleet of Ohioclass submarines ported at Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay and another Navy base in Bangor, Wash. "Where are you from"?, I asked knowing that my hotel was usually filled with all sorts of people from different Asian countries. She giggled and told me, "Thailand of course, where are you from"? "I am from the United States". But, it did not register with her. Thinking quickly I came back with, "I am from America". She gasped. She looked at me and with lots of enthusiasm, eyes big, and told me, "I want to go to America"! "I hope you do, you will like it", I responded. And with that the doors opened and she disappeared down the hall.

I thought to myself as the elevator continued up to my floor that she had probably just met her first American. And, whatever she had learned about our country she wanted to come and see it. With that guick exchange I became a representation to that young girl of everything that I am proud to be – an American. Happy July 4th to all of you.

Navy commodore to be relieved of command over Iran's capture

The commodore in charge of the two U.S. Navy boats that strayed into Iranian waters leading to the capture of his 10 sailors for 16 hours in January will be relieved of command likely putting an end to his career, Fox News has learned.

Capt. Kyle Moses, commodore of Commander Task Force (CTF) 56 was responsible for the two riverine boats and Kuwait-based crew. The Chief of Naval Operations, Admiral John Richardson, is

set to release a long-awaited report on June 30th about the events surrounding the January incident now that the investigation is complete.

Iranian Revolutionary Guard forces captured the two high-speed patrol boats near Farsi Island, a well-known Iranian base, hours after the boats left Kuwait on January 12 with the intended purpose of sailing to Bahrain. Five sailors were aboard each boat.

The Navy crew was inexperienced and running late to make a rendezvous at a refueling point in the Persian Gulf when the capture took place, according to officials.

The detention of the American crew came the same day as President Obama's State of the Union address and came at a sensitive time for the administration days before formally implementing the nuclear deal between Iran and six world powers led by the United States.

Days after the incident, Defense Secretary Ash Carter said the Navy patrol boats had "misnavigated" into Iranian territorial waters. The second in command of the riverine squadron, Cmdr. Eric Rasch, was fired from his job last month.

Multiple defense officials tell Fox News a "multitude of errors" led to the capture of the U.S. Navy crew.

First, there was no navigation brief, a major violation of Navy protocol. When any Navy ship gets underway, even for something as minor as shirting berths from one pier to another, it is standard for a Navy crew to conduct a navigation brief discussing issues such as hazards to navigation or, in this case, an Iranian base near the planned course.

Second, the chain of command was not well defined on the two boats. While a young lieutenant was the highest-ranking individual on either of the two 50-foot boats, when the order was given to evade the Iranian forces, the helmsman refused the order.

Third, defense officials tell Fox News the Navy had become too complacent with the its treatment by Iranian forces in the months leading up to the January capture.

"The story here is these guys had gotten so used to Iranians doing stupid s---, having weapons pointed at them all the time, they didn't know they were being captured until the Iranians boarded their boats," one defense official said describing the lack of situational awareness by the Navy crew. "They messed up pretty bad."
