#### Commissioner Names New Legal Counsel for Juvenile Justice

**Top Indigent Defense Lawyer Cindy Wang Joins DJJ Leadership Team** (DECATUR - GA) Commissioner Avery D. Niles is pleased to announce the hire of attorney Cindy Wang as the new General Counsel for the Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice. Director Wang joins the department after more than a decade as a top lawyer for Georgia's indigent defense agency. In her new role, Ms. Wang will oversee all legal issues involving the department, including individual litigation and state and federal law compliance.

#### State panel considers cannabis business case

Georgia is famous for square acres of peaches and blueberries. Now, say some, there's a case for a crop measured by square feet: medical marijuana. "There is a good, effective business model for what Georgia allows now," said state Rep. Allen Peake, R-Macon, just after a Wednesday hearing of the Georgia Commission on Medical Cannabis. Growing plain old illegal weed is enough of an money-maker that plenty of people in Georgia grow more than they could ever use, and plenty of them get busted.(Ga Trend)

#### Chinese recreational vehicle company bringing 80 jobs to Gwinnett County

A Chinese recreational vehicles company announced plans on Wednesday to open a facility near Gwinnett Place Mall, making it the second company from China to announce this week that it is coming to Gwinnett County. Linhai Powersports USA is expected to create 80 jobs over the next five years as it gets its new 6,078-squarefoot facility at the Gwinnett Corporate Center, 1775 Corporate Dr., up and running. The facility will include office space and a distribution warehouse. (Ga Trend)

#### 2015 ACT results: Georgia a leading Southern state

Staff reports that 2015 ACT results shows Georgia at the top of the pack among Southern states, outperforming Alabama, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee, Arkansas, Florida, West Virginia, South Carolina and Texas. Georgia students also scored higher than those in Colorado, Illinoi, Michigan, Montana, North Dakota, Utah, Wyoming, Arkansas, Hawaii and Arizona. (Ga Trend)

#### Georgia colleges recruit researchers

Pending about \$12 million to recruit eight world-class scientists and 60 of their colleagues is bringing Georgia universities more than \$27 million in federal research grants, the Georgia Research Alliance announced. Half of the recruitment costs for lab space and equipment were borne by taxpayer appropriations from the General Assembly with the balance from donations. The mostly federal research grants cover nearly all expenses to pay and equip the 60 scientists who follow what the alliance called the "eminent scholars" they recruit.(Ga Trend)

#### Delta adding flights to London and Edinburgh

Staff reports that the Delta Air Lines Inc. (NYSE: DAL) and Virgin Atlantic joint venture will start nonstop service from Salt Lake City to London Heathrow and New York-JFK to Edinburgh, Scotland, in May 2016. Salt Lake City will be Atlanta-based Delta's eighth U.S. destination from Heathrow and the only nonstop service between London and the Mountain West. (Ga Trend)

#### Georgia DNR board considering new duck hunting, fishing regulations

Outdoors enthusiasts could face changes in what they can bring home from hunting and fishing trips based proposed changes in regulations up for votes by the Georgia Board of Natural Resources. The board is expected to vote in two months on increasing the minimum size on spotted seatrout, a prized salt water species, from 13 inches to 14 inches and Wednesday on increasing the limit on canvasback ducks. (Ga Trend)

#### Health insurance rates could climb significantly

Health insurance policyholders might see premium increases as high as 38 percent next year, a Gainesville insurance executive told a Gainesville audience Tuesday. Proposed rates vary from 12 percent for Blue Cross Blue Shield's small group plans to 38 percent for Alliant Health Plans, said Brett Fowler, vice president and partner of Turner, Wood & Smith Insurance, speaking at the Greater Hall Chamber of Commerce's fourth annual health care reform update. (Ga Trend)

### The Raping of America: Mile Markers on the Road to Fascism

"Freedom is never voluntarily given by the oppressor; it must be demanded by the oppressed."-Martin Luther King Jr. There's an ill will blowing across the country. The economy is tanking. The people are directionless, and politics provides no answer. And like former regimes, the militarized police have stepped up to provide a facade of law and order manifested by an overt violence against the citizenry.

Despite the revelations of the past several years, nothing has changed to push back against the American police state. Our freedoms-especially the Fourth Amendment-continue to be choked out by a prevailing view among government bureaucrats that they have the right to search, seize, strip, scan, spy on, probe, pat down, taser, and arrest any individual at any time and for the slightest provocation.

Despite the recent outrage and protests, nothing has changed to restore us to our rightful role as having dominion over our bodies, our lives and our property, especially when it comes to interactions with the government.

Special Forced cavity searches, forced colonoscopies, forced blood draws, forced breath-alcohol tests, forced DNA extractions, forced eye scans, forced inclusion in biometric databases—these are just a few ways in which Americans continue to be reminded that we have no control over what happens to our bodies during an encounter with government officials. Thus far, the courts have done little to preserve our Fourth Amendment rights, let alone what shreds of bodily integrity remain to us.

Indeed, on a daily basis, Americans are being forced to relinquish the most intimate details of who we are-our biological makeup, our genetic blueprints, and our biometrics (facial characteristics and structure, fingerprints, iris scans, etc.)-in order to clear the nearly insurmountable hurdle that increasingly defines life in the United States.


In other words, we are all guilty until proven innocent. Worst of all, it seems as if nothing will change as long as the American people remain distracted by politics, divided by their own prejudices, and brainwashed into believing that the Constitution still reigns supreme as the law of the land, when in fact, we have almost completed the shift into fascism.

First, however, Americans must break free of the apathyinducing turpor of politics, entertainment spectacles and manufactured news. Only once we are free of the chains that bind us—or to be more exact, the chains that "blind" us—can we become actively aware of the injustices taking place around us and demand freedom from our oppressors. 



### **Chicken in Creamy Sun Dried Tomato Sauce**

#### Ingredients
