White County: Tasting Success

Wineries, transportation improvements and education

A shuttle bus winds around the corner, quietly crunching the gravel driveway at The Cottage Vineyard and Winery in Cleveland. It's nearly 1 p.m. on a Friday, and the six-person group with VIP Southern Wine Tours marks the informal start of weekend business for The Cottage – and seven other wineries in White County. In the stable-style tasting room, the group samples whites such as Vidal Blanc and reds like Cabernet Sauvignon.

Former New Yorker Jim Penner spent his career in the U.S. Air Force and met winemakers when he was stationed in Germany. ("Some of the best white wines in the world," he says.) After he retired, he started with a vineyard at home, just down the street from The Cottage, which he and his wife, Sandra, opened in 2012. Now his winery, on 29 acres, is open seven days a week.

"We've grown exponentially, for sure," he says, adding that his largest weekend crowds reach 300 people. "We have our faithful locals, and when I say local, I'm talking about a radius from Alpharetta to Blairsville. Probably two-thirds of people we pour for are still finding us."

In fact, White County, located 80 miles north of Atlanta, appears to have the most wineries of any county in Georgia, says chamber of commerce President Cindy Bailey.

The wineries have represented an estimated investment of \$30 million in the last 10 years, says Tom O'Bryant, director of community and economic development for White County. "It's just created a whole new economy up here," he says.

Wineries and tourists, including the droves who clink beer steins during Octoberfest in the Bavarian Alpine village of Helen, aren't the only ones infusing a sense of excitement in White County. Since 2012, 25 commercial projects with an investment value of more than \$62 million have been either completed, are under construction or in development review.

Growth brings growing pains, especially in the area of transportation, but the \$25-million Appalachian Parkway aims to relieve bottlenecks on Hwy. 129 by circumventing downtown Cleveland. The four-lane parkway has experienced delays, but the \$15.1-million first phase was set to open in 2015; work has begun on phase 2; and a third phase to finish the eight-mile roadway is awaiting funding.

"The traffic, especially in the fall, just really backs up in Cleveland. With this parkway, it's going to help tremendously," says Jerry Brown, executive director of the Alpine Helen/White County Georgia CVB.

A COUPLE HELL-BENT ON JIHAD?

Husband & wife Muslim gunmen were armed to the teeth for death mission; FBI tracking digital trail for terror link

The Muslim couple who stormed an office holiday party in Southern California Wednesday, gunning down 14 of his co-workers before dying hours later in a shootout with police, had a massive arsenal of guns, ammo and bombs in their nearby home, where authorities seized cell phones and computer drives that could contain evidence they were radicalized terrorists with more targets in their sights, authorities said.

Local and federal authorities - as well as President Obama - continued Thursday to resist calling the carnage at a San Bernardino social services facility terrorism, even as evidence mounted that the pair, who wore tactical gear and moved with grim precision, may have been jihadists armed to the teeth and hellbent on slaughtering innocent Americans. More than 5,000 rounds of ammunition were later found in their home, which sources described as "an IED factory" packed with explosives and bomb-making equipment.

"At this stage, we do not yet know why this terrible event occurred," Obama said in an address from the White House. "We'll get to the bottom of this and be vigilant getting the facts before we issue decisive judgments on how this occurred."

Syed Rizwan Farook, a U.S.-born citizen of Pakistani descent who had recently traveled to Saudi Arabia and begun wearing a full beard, and Tashfeen Malik, 27, burst into the facility Wednesday morning and sprayed up to 75 rounds at Farook's own terrified colleagues in a conference room where his employer, the county health department, was hosting a holiday party. The pair escaped in a black SUV after the attack, which authorities said was over within as few as 10 minutes, only to resurface three hours later and less than 2 miles away in a fierce gun battle on the city's main drag.

"They came prepared to do what they did, as if they were on a mission," San Bernardino Police Chief Jarrod Burguan said.

Prayer puts our faith at risk.

When we "pray to God in faith believing" and nothing happens or the results are different from what we expected or there is no answer at all, the tendency is to question the goodness and wisdom of God. Nor is it unusual for people to doubt the need for prayer when or if they don't get what they want.

As we begin to read Psalm 28 David seems to be having a problem in his prayer life. "I pray to You, O Lord, my Rock. Do not turn a deaf ear to me." Notice the way he begins: "I pray to You!" His prayer is direct and intense. But there is something very important to be noted here. In this moment of need David, in no uncertain terms. lets us into his heart. Prayer was not just part of his life. It was at the center of his life. He was completely dependent upon the Lord for help. "You, O Lord, are my Rock!" This prayer, though we do not know specifically what David was praying for, arose from a definite need at a specific time in his life. Perhaps years later, when he was writing of this experience, he could not remember specifically what his request was, but he could not forget that he had a need that only God could meet. And God met that need and granted his request.

In this prayer we hear his cry and see his hands raised to God demonstrating his dependence on Yahweh. And his prayer was answered. "Praise be to the Lord," he finally shouted, "for He has heard my cry for mercy."

God always answers us - but on His terms.

Origin of Christmas

Christmas or Christmas Day (Old English: Crīstesmæsse, meaning "Christ's Mass") is an annual festival commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ,[7][8] observed most commonly on December 25[4][9][10] as a religious and cultural celebration among billions of people around the world.[2][11][12] A feast central to the Christian liturgical year, it is prepared for by the season of Advent or Nativity Fast and is prolonged by the Octave of Christmas

and further by the season of Christmastide. Christmas Day is a public holiday in many of the world's nations,[13][14][15] is celebrated culturally by a large number of non-Christian people,[1][16][17] and is an integral part of the Christmas and holiday season.

The celebratory customs associated in various countries with Christmas have a mix of pre-Christian, Christian, and secular themes and origins.[18] Popular modern customs of the holiday include gift



giving, completing an Advent calendar or Advent wreath, Christmas music and caroling, an exchange of Christmas cards, church services, a special meal, and the display of various Christmas decorations, including Christmas trees, Christmas lights, nativity scenes, garlands, wreaths, mistletoe, and holly. In addition, several closely related and often interchangeable figures, known as Santa Claus, Father Christmas, Saint Nicholas, and Christkind, are associated with bringing gifts to children during the Christmas season and have their own body of traditions and lore.[19] Because gift-giving and many other aspects of the Christmas festival involve heightened economic activity, the holiday has become a significant event and a key sales period for retailers and businesses. The economic impact of Christmas is a factor that has grown steadily over the past few centuries in many regions of the world.

While the month and date of Jesus' birth are unknown, by the early-to-mid 4th century, the Western Christian Church had placed Christmas on December 25,[20] a date later adopted in the East,[21][22] although some churches celebrate on the December 25 of the older Julian calendar, which, in the Gregorian calendar, currently corresponds to January 7, the day after the Western Christian Church celebrates the Epiphany. The date of Christmas may have initially been chosen to correspond with the day exactly nine months after the day on which early Christians believed that Jesus was conceived,[23] or with one or more ancient polytheistic festivals that occurred near southern solstice (i.e., the Roman winter solstice);[24][25] a further solar connection has been suggested because of a biblical verse[a] identifying Jesus as the "Sun of righteousness".[23][26][27] -Wikepedia

Thousands gather for NYC Rockefeller Center Christmas tree lighting

NEW YORK -- A 10-ton Christmas tree with 45,000 LED lights covering about five miles of wire has come alive in the rain to cap New York City's annual ritual in Rockefeller Center.

The ceremony -- nationally televised by NBC on Wednesday evening -- included performances by Sting, Mary J. Blige, Andrea Bocelli and James Taylor. Tens of thousands had a close-up view of the show. The celebration came with security restrictions including a prohibition on umbrellas. Backpacks also were barred.

Streets surrounding Rockefeller Plaza were closed and spectators were kept behind police barricades. NYPD Commissioner Bill Bratton says no credible threat has been reported.

The holiday tradition started in 1931. This year's tree came from upstate Gardiner, New York. After the holidays, it will be milled into lumber for Habitat for Humanity.



Butternut Squash Soup

Ingredients

2 tablespoons butter

1 small onion, chopped

1 stalk celery, chopped

1 medium carrot, chopped

2 medium potatoes, cubed

1 medium butternut squash - peeled, seeded, and cubed

1 (32 fluid ounce) container chicken stock

salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste

Instructions
