### Team Requirements

**ALL PLAYERS MUST HAVE PLAYED AT LEAST 12  
WEEKS, IN MICHIGAN, TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY  
EVENT.** Only 1 Master Player on an Open team. NO  
Master & Intermediate player can play together on an  
Open Team. 2 Intermediate players are equal to 1 Master  
player and eligible to play together.

**OPEN TEAM: MUST have 2 original players from the  
same team.** Remaining players may come from within  
their charter holder league system.

**MEN'S MASTER TEAM:** Any 5 players within their charter  
holder league system.

**LADIES TEAM: MUST have 2 original players from the  
same roster.** Other players may come from within their  
charter holder league system.

**LADIES MASTER TEAM:** Any 4 players within their  
charter holder league system.

**DRESS CODE:** All participants must comply with the  
following dress code: **No Halter Tops • No Midriiffs • No Cut-  
Offs • No Swimwear • No Tube Tops • No Tank Tops • No  
Improper Verbiage.** All shorts must be clean, neat, presentable,  
hemmed and of proper length to be allowed. Rugged cut-offs will  
not be allowed. All players, during their scheduled matches, will  
present themselves in a neat and clean appearance. Tournament  
Officials will have the right to ask any player or spectator not  
properly attired to leave the playing area.
