- 4 MPH Speed Limit, Antique.
- 5MPH Speed Limit, Farm Stock.
- 9500 Farm 8MPH.
- 200lb Grace.
- 5500 & 6500 Light Improved, No Speed Limit.
- Registration 10:30AM / Start Time 12PM.

ANTIQUE TRACTOR RULES - 2025

- 1. Antique class tractors must be 1957, or older
- 2. 4mph speed limit in all classes
- 3. All tractors must have manufactured clevis no pulling hitches
- 4. All tractors must have original drawbar
- 5. Drawbar height maximum will be 20"
- 6. There is a 200lb grace limit
- 7. No cut tires or wheelie bars
- 8. PTO must work if it came with the tractor
- 9. Speed Limit: 4 mph
- 10. Driver MUST pull in their assigned order!
 - If a driver fails to pull in the correct order, they may be disqualified.
 - Only one Tractor/Driver per class
- 11. No reckless driving including digging holes.
- 12. Tractors will be stopped if the front wheels are more than 18" above ground.
 - Judged by flagman
- 13. Operator must remain seated in a safe manner
- 14. Loss of weight or any part any part of the tractor during pull will be grounds for disqualification
- 15. All drivers pull at their own risk.
 - Neither Gas-Lite nor any sponsor will be held responsible for any accidents, deaths, or injuries!
- 16. Antique tractors cannot have a turbo
- 17. Two sizes above stock tires
- 18. No press steel wheels allowed unless they came factory on the tractor

FARM STOCK TRACTOR RULES - 2025

- 1. 5mph speed limit
- 2. NO CUT TIRES or special pulling tires built by some tire companies.
- 3. Speed limit is 5 mph in Farm classes, MPH judged by board at end of track. Once over the limit is first warning, twice over the limit is disqualification.
- 4. Stock draw bars, NO pulling or homemade hitches.
- 5. Loss of weight at any part of Tractor during pull will be grounds for disqualification.
- 6. Violations of any rule shall constitute a disqualification. All judges' decisions are final.
 - Arguing with judges will not be tolerated; this behavior will make you eligible for immediate disqualification.
- 7. Drawbar height maximum will be 20" to the top of the clevis.
- 8. Tractors will be stopped if the front wheels are 18" above the ground. At the Flagman's discretion.
- 9. All pulls must start with a tight chain and be straight with the sled, and contestants will be allowed two consecutive attempts and 100 feet to start the sled.
- 10. Driver MUST pull in their assigned order! If a driver fails to pull in the correct order, they may be disqualified. Only one Tractor/Driver per class.
- 11. Tractors will have hoods, grills, and a seat. On fuel only unless your tractor starts on one fuel and runs on another.
- 12. Tractors must have working hydraulics and PTO if it came from the factory that way.
 - 13.200lb grace
- 14. Any issues with someone else's tractor it MUST be addressed at the Driver's meeting before the pull starts.
