Whiskey is a spirit distilled from malted grain; including barley, rye, wheat & com. Once distilled, it is typically aged in wooden casks of oak from where it draws its characteristic chemical composition, taste and particular nose. The word whiskey comes from the gaelic 'Uisce beatha' which translates to 'the water of life' and its meaning traces back to the original 'medicinal' nature of its production.

Although all whiskeys are not the same, they share these characteristics. But let's find out what makes them unique

Scotch Whisky

All Scotch whisky was originally made from malted barley, but over the centuries commercial distillers have begun adding wheat and rye to some whiskies.

Essentially Scotch is divided into five distinct categories:

- Single Malt Scotch Whiskey (distilled in a single distillery and 100% malted barley)
- Single Grain Scotch Whisky (single distillery, any grain other than barley)
- Blended Malt Scotch Whisky (formerly called "vatted malt" or "pure malt")
- Blended Grain Scotch Whisky (a blend of two or more single grain scotch whiskies from different distilleries)
- Blended Scotch Whisky (a blend of one or more single malt scotch whiskies with one or more single grain scotch whiskies from different distilleries)

All Scotch whisky must be aged in Scotland in oak barrels for at least three years. Any age statement on a bottle of Scotch whisky, expressed in numerical form, must reflect the age of the youngest whisky used to produce that product. A whisky with an age statement is known as guaranteed-age whisky.
