- Children and adults should put electronic devices down, keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street




WELCOME



WHEN to invest in a Certificate of Deposit (CD)

Interest earned on savings can add extra money in your pocket over time, but a savings account typically pays the lowest interest rate when considering savings options. One option with higher

When the Federal Reserve raises interest rates, it's usually because the economy is experiencing rising inflation. This is an important factor to consider before investing in a CD, as this investment option locks your money in for a period of time.

If interest rates are high, and you have funds on hand that you do not anticipate needing in the near future, a CD can be a great choice to earn significantly more than letting it sit in a savings account.

Roasted sweet potatoes brown butter pierogies

Prep time: 10 minutes Cook time: 30 minutes Servings: 4-5

- 1 bag (1.6 pounds) Mrs. T's Mini Classic Cheddar Pierogies
- 2 cups sweet potato cubes (approximately 1 large or 2 medium sweet potatoes, cut into 1/2-inch cubes)
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- salt, to taste
- pepper, to taste
- 4 tablespoons salted butter
- 1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1/2 cup pecans
- · fresh thyme leaves, for serving

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 400 F.
- Toss sweet potato cubes in olive oil, salt and pepper, to taste, and spread in even layer on baking sheet. Roast 25-30 minutes, tossing about halfway through, until potatoes are fork tender.



- In medium skillet over medium heat, brown butter 5-10 minutes. Avoid smoking or burning. Remove from heat. Allow to cool about 5 minutes then whisk in balsamic vinegar and lemon juice.
- In large saucepan, bring water to boil. Cook pierogies according to package directions, about 3 minutes. Drain and toss in brown butter sauce.
- Add roasted sweet potatoes and pecans to brown butter pierogies and toss gently
- Top with fresh thyme leaves.

Were you invited to dine at the community? How was the experience? Mealtime is central to the quality of life at every care community. Are the food choices fresh, healthy and tasty? What is service like in the dining room? Are there choices for variations on the daily dining experience? Would you want to eat there again?

While choosing the right community may take some time, asking the right questions can bring you closer to finding what you want. ESTATE planning mistakes to watch out for

In our practice, we see many clients who have an outdated estate plan. Even if you have a will and powers of attorney, they may not meet your current needs. Here are three problems to watch out for:



You named the wrong executor or trustee

Your executor or trustee should be someone you trust. Outdated estate plans often name fiduciaries or successor fiduciaries who are no longer suited for the position. An executor named years earlier may be too old or may have died. A trustee who will be in charge of managing assets may no longer be close to the family. A guardian may not be necessary if your children are no longer minors.

Your children are older

When your children are young, your primary goal is to name a guardian to help raise them and provide a structure (often by trust) for management of money. If your child is now an adult, these concerns may no longer be relevant.

Perhaps your children will now take over the role of executor or trustee. Or, if your child isn't financially responsible, maybe you want to extend that trust to provide continuing oversight of assets. You may have new issues arise as well, such as preserving an inheritance for grandchildren or protecting it from divorce.

Your medical authority is defective

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) was passed in 1996 to establish national standards for protecting the confidentiality of medical records. As a general rule, your powers of attorney - medical directives, living wills and durable financial power of attorney - should contain stipulations waiving HIPAA protections so that your agent can communicate with your physician about your care.

These provisions ensure that your doctor can share important information about you so that your agent can make informed health care decisions. Without these protections, doctors may be unwilling to share medical information. If your powers of attorney are old enough, they may not even reference HIPAA.

It is important to review your estate planning documents every so often due to everchanging tax laws and major life events. You should consider revisiting your plan every three to five years. Life can change, and it is vital to meet with your attorney to avoid potential

Two measures of success for any recurring endeavor are longevity and growth. The holiday basket giveaway in Clive is a success according to both criteria, and Ed Johnson



of the Clive Lions Club has enjoyed being part of that for many years.

Along with Donna Krupko, Johnson heads up the Lions Club's involvement in the tradition which gives a generously filled basket to each recipient family during the holiday season.

"The holiday basket program has been going on in one form or another for over 30 years," says Johnson.

He explains that the program was begun by Crestview school, with the Lions Club helping to deliver the baskets. Eventually, as the program grew, it became more labor-intensive.

"The Lions Club decided that they would take it over as one of their main projects, and, to this day, it is still our largest community project that we do," says Johnson, who has been a member of the Lions Club since 1997.

"About ten years ago, we decided that it was such a good project, and the need was so great, that we would see if we could expand it to include

a lot more families," he says.

Soon, the program swelled to around 40 recipient families.

Many organizations and individuals help make the program a success, and because of this, the program has grown to serve roughly 85 families per year. Johnson points out that 85 families equates to more than 300 individuals, so the giveaway is even larger than it sounds. The Clive Food Bank provides names of families that could benefit from the giveaway, and two local churches (Faith Lutheran and Connections Christian Church) help with seeking donations. Johnson hesitates to try to list all of the helpers, for fear of omitting any.

"It's a real community effort," he says.

The basic process is that the Lions ask for food and other donations from local grocers and merchants. Monetary donations are also welcomed.

"With the money we collect, we buy perishables the day before we deliver," he says. "All the Lions Club members are very active in this endeavor. We buy age- and gender-specific toys. We also include gas cards and purchase things for the homes, kitchen items, disposable diapers, and things like this. At the end of the day, we have a pretty nice basket with very appropriate and needed things for these 85 families."

Some staple items, such as sugar or flour, will be in every basket, as the Lions ask grocers to donate and/or sell 85 bags of these items.

"We deliver these baskets to the families in early December," says Johnson. "This is such a rewarding experience to do this. It's so nice to see the look on the kids' faces when we deliver these packages."

Johnson notes, if citizens wish to help, the best way is by a donation through Venmo or by sending a donation to Clive City Hall with a note, "Friends of the Clive Lions Club."

"The community has been so supportive," says Johnson. "There have been so many donors, big and small. They're all valuable. We've just had so much fun doing this." ■

- 3. Physical therapy can lower patient treatment costs by up to 72%. Surgical candidates are often referred to physical therapy because its services can lower treatment costs by up to 72%. In physical therapy, we focus on strengthening and increasing mobility which, as a result, can sometimes prevent surgery and spare your pockets the hurt.
- 4. The average course of outpatient therapy is seven to 10 sessions. While each plan of care is individualized, the average course of outpatient therapy only requires 7-10

sessions. Although some patients experience either more or fewer follow-up appointments, PT is most effective with consistent visits for several weeks.

5. Women were the pioneers for physical therapy in the U.S. Physical therapy was initiated in response to World War I, in which the army utilized "reconstruction aides," or nurses, who provided rehabilitation to wounded soldiers. These women often worked 14-hour strenuous days. Little did they know they would later shape an entire profession.

ECZEMA: causes and treatment

LONGEVITY and the mouth-body connection

When we think about getting healthier, losing weight and living longer, oral health rarely comes to mind. We know we need a healthier heart, healthier lungs, a healthier brain. But what about a healthier mouth?



The mouth is connected to every other system in your body. The state of your oral health can impact your heart, your lungs, susceptibility to dementia, the quality of your sleep, levels of

inflammation and toxicity throughout the body, and even whether you have trouble conceiving or not. This is how caring for your mouth will let you live a longer, healthier, better life.

Quality of life steadily decreases as we approach the end of life. This is how most of us age if we are not thinking preventatively and taking care of ourselves. Maintaining a quality of life can be done with prevention, good diet, exercise and taking care of our bodies physically and emotionally. The way you take care of your oral health will affect all of those things — for better or worse.

Taking care of your mouth determines:

- Levels of toxicity and inflammation throughout the body
- Inflammatory load on the heart and entire cardiovascular system
- Resistance to dementia
- The health of your pregnancy and your baby

Even a simple cavity is connected to your heart health, microbiome and brain health. Teeth are precious organs that are critical to the proper functioning of the whole body. What happens in the mouth, happens in the body.

There is a barrier between the gums and teeth and the rest of the body. This barrier breaks down a little bit every time there is inflammation or infection in the mouth, triggering disease and dysfunction in other parts of the body. The mouth is the only place in the body where bone-like structures protrude out of the skin.

Surrounding each tooth is a tight girdle of fibers pulling the gums snugly around the neck of the tooth. This tight seal is designed to keep elements out. In a healthy mouth with no infection, the seal is tight, and the pathway between mouth bacteria and the bloodstream is closed. When an infection is present in the gums, the seal is weakened and elements from the outside environment can get past the gums and into the bloodstream, infecting all other systems.

Among the conditions that can be caused or complicated by an oral Infection are: IBS, breast cancer, prostate cancer, diabetes, Alzheimer's and dementia, cardiovascular diseases, osteoporosis.

To take care of your oral health, remember to brush after meals and floss, eat the right foods, and see your dentist regularly.

Making better oral health decisions might have a huge impact on your overall health. ■


