# Beaverdale: Welcome to the neighborhood



Beaverdale is a Des Moines neighborhood defined by the boundaries of Meredith Drive to the north, Forest Avenue to the south, 30th Street to the east and 48th Place to the west. But, more than that, it is defined by the pride of its residents, its vitality and its vibrant history. The "Beaverdale Brick" homes, tree-lined streets, parks and quaint shops give the neighborhood its character.

Beaverdale is the largest of the 51 recognized neighborhoods in Des Moines. The Beaverdale Neighborhood Association (BNA) is an active organization, promoting community events and involvement. The BNA is led by an 11-member board elected for two-year terms. The Board meets monthly and works closely with several committees to accomplish the goals of the association.

The BNA is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization committed to ensuring that Beaverdale remains a vital community in which to live. Formed in June 1990, it quickly became one of the largest neighborhood associations in Des Moines.

A primary goal of the BNA is to give all Beaverdale residents an active voice in the future of the neighborhood by working closely with the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Beaverdale businesses and organizations and neighbors to implement actions that cover the major issues facing the residential, commercial and public facets of the area. The BNA MISSION is to promote the social welfare of the Beaverdale area by bringing about civic betterment and social improvements for the common good and general welfare of the people of the community.

# How do I start garbage, recycling or yard waste collection services?

Department of Public Works 24-Hour Customer Service Center at 515-283-4950. Fees for premium yard waste collection are included as solid waste charges on your monthly Des Moines Water Works bill.

- Recycling pick up: Fill out the Recycling Request Form online at https://www.dsm.city/interactive\_forms/recycling\_request\_form.php.
- Yard waste pick up: Fill out the Yard Waste Form online at https://www.dsm.city/departments/public\_works-division/garbage\_collection/yard\_waste\_collection.php.
  The City of Des Moines Department of Public Works Solid Waste Division provides yard waste collection service to Des Moines residents year-round.

#### Is a spring cleanup event offered?

SCRUB (Spring Cleanup to Reduce Urban Blight) events are offered by the Public Works Department. It is the City's mission to enhance the City's neighborhoods by allowing residents an opportunity to remove yard waste and debris from homes and yards to reduce the blighted areas within the city.

#### How do I license a pet?

You can license a pet online at https://www.dsm.city/departments/city\_clerk/animal\_licensing.php.

All dogs and cats older than 6 months needs to be licensed. The fee is due Jan. 1 each year, but there's a grace period until March 31 before the city starts charging late fees. If your pet will not turn 6 months old until after March 31, you won't have to pay a late fee, but you need to register them as soon as they are old enough. The same applies to those who bring home a new pet or move into Des Moines after March 31. You can use an adoption form from a local

rescue to provide proof of a new pet or provide a utility bill for proof of a new address.

If your cat or dog is spayed or neutered, the fee is \$15 per animal. If your pet is not fixed, it's \$35 per animal. If you are 65 years old or older, you may register one cat and one dog for \$5 each, with additional animals at the regular fee.

#### What are the snow removal regulations?



The Department of Public Works is dedicated to providing residents with professional snow removal services. It takes hundreds of Public Works, Parks and Recreation and WRA employees and a partnership with Des Moines



residents to operate the 100 pieces of equipment that are necessary to clear city streets effectively.

As a general rule, while snow is still falling, plow trucks are working on designated main snow routes that are designed so that no one is ever more than four blocks from a snow route. Once the snow stops, the plow trucks transition into plowing all of the residential roads

that do not fall into the snow route system. Parking restrictions are not actively enforced in neighborhoods until snowfall stops and an issued residential snow ordinance goes into effect. However, residents are encouraged not to park on residential streets during snowfall when possible.

The website offers helpful information for those who have not used the service and have questions about boarding busses, paying fares, and the other basics.

The Franklin Avenue Library is a Des Moines Public Library. It hosts many events and programs for children, teenagers and adults, and has meeting rooms available to the public. It serves the needs, wants and tastes of its community of patrons with a collection of more than 100,000 items. #### **BIKE TRAILS**

Access to the Inter-Urban Trail is available at nearly any point off of Urbandale Avenue, but your best bet is the intersection with 34th Street or 30th Street. East of the Des Moines River, trail access is only available off of the Neal Smith Trail. Public parking is available at Beaverdale Park or on most of the residential streets of Beaverdale. Be respectful of the property of the residents of the neighborhood.

The trail system continues to be one of the most popular amenities in the park system. Recent counts indicate users take more than 1 million trail trips each year. With 68 miles of paved and 19 miles of soft trails, there is something and some way for everyone to get out and be active — from mountain bikers to runners and walkers of all ages. Trails are not just for exercise; numerous riders use trails for their daily commute, year-round. The network in Des Moines serves as a nucleus for the state, with connectivity to more than 550 miles in central Iowa.




