**Question**

Shall the Board of Education of Layayette County C-1 School District be authorized to increase the operating property tax levy ceiling to \$3.7008 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation according to the 2023 assessment for the purpose of paying general operating expenses and increasing compensation for employees in order to attract and retain quality faculty and staff?

If this question is approved, the adjusted operating property tax levy of the District is expected to increase by \$0.2500 from \$3.4508 to \$3.7008 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and the District expects to make a corresponding reduction of its debt service property tax levy of \$0.2500 resulting in the estimated overall District adjusted property tax levy remaining unchanged at \$4.5639 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
