Mayor's Reports - Maggie Ridge

- Bear's Playgrounds passed the final steps from the Planning Board and the
 Zoning Board of Appeals to expand their business to a large and vacant facility
 on Main Street. We are all very excited about this additional new business and
 would like to extend a warm welcome to them.
- We'd also like to welcome Elonoc Towing to the Village. They're occupying the space at 67 Rochester St. and the long-term plans are to eventually purchase the land.
- Radar speed signs are installed and collecting data. So far, the highest speed recorded was 86 miles per hour on Rochester Street at 5:00 AM. The second one is on Chili Avenue past the school and the recorded speeds were 65 – 68 MPH.
- Extreme excess speeding seems to occur in the mornings. I do see people hitting their brakes when the speed sign flashes, so it's working to mitigate some of the problem.
- Met with the Historic Preservation Commission. They are re-working some of the language on the Certificate of Appropriateness application.
- Andy and I worked on a draft of the lease agreement with the Fire Company for the Ballfield. Emailed it to Jay for their comments and concerns. Once we get the basics of the things that are important to all parties, we'll have it reviewed by the attorneys and develop the formal document.
- Met with the Forestry Board they are re-working the info letter regarding Village removal of a tree in the ROW.
- Met with Chris Chambry (MCSO) to review a few things and we both commented on how quiet and peaceful things were in the Village. That was the day before the Cool Whip truck fire and the incident at Cooper Vision.
- My January focus will be on ways the Village can bring back some of the social events that fell away due to COVID and/or budget cuts and/or lack of volunteers.
