Scheduling of meetings

 Meeting date was changed from 3/9 to 3/16 to allow for a majority of board members to attend. Regular meeting date resumes on April 14 – the second Thursday of each month.

Guest speaker

- Kevin Marks presented information about the Genesee Valley Trail Towns Initiative.
 - The Wheatland GVTTI team is made up of local citizens that represent our community. It is one of 10 teams from towns in the Genesee Valley dedicated to creating a positive collective impact on the region. The GVTTI is supported by PTNY, FOGVG and LGV with financial contributions from the Ralph C. Wilson Jr Foundation, USDA and NBRC. Parks & Trails New York is the leading statewide advocate for parks and trails in the state. The work is scheduled to be completed in 2022 and 2023.
 - Our 2022 PTNY grant award of \$11,383 plus matching funds from supporting partners totals \$17,000. With this, we are installing information kiosks in Canawaugus Park and Mumford, bike racks, a bike repair station, wayfinding signage, improvements to crosswalks, and more. We are working towards fulfilling the NYS GV Greenway Master Plan of having Scottsville be the Northern Gateway to the Genesee Valley.
 - Discussion on how the Forestry Board can align efforts in Canawaugus Park to enhance the entry point to the northern gateway for this initiative.
