

## League Scoring Information

### Stroke Play League Scoring

There will be a total of 25 points available each week. The A players will be playing against each other for one point per hole and the B players against each other for one point per hole for a total of 18 of the 25 possible points. The player in each match with the highest number of holes won, receives 2 points. If there is a tie each player is awarded 1 point. Finally, the two teammates will combine their nine hole net scores (Actual strokes, minus handicap) to tabulate an 18 hole net score. The lower 18 hole net score team wins 3 points. In the case of a tie each team is awarded a 1½ points. This is how we come to 25 points per match per week. **There will be a sample card available in the Ladies Locker Room for you to reference.**

If using a substitute player, please update your pre-made card for the round, with the first and last name and handicap of the sub. Also be sure that the appropriate A & B players are matched correctly with the other teams A & B player.

**NOTE: A maximum handicap of 20 for nine holes will be allowed for league this year per the recommendation of the Iowa Golf Association.**

**Cards will be pre-made for each weeks round and placed in the locker room for pick up.**

**After your round, please add up your scores, (one person from each team must sign the card), then return the card to the bartender.** Your scores will be entered into the GHIN handicap program by the stroke league golf committee member.

One team should use the premade score card (one with names & handicaps) for keeping score, and the other team should keep another score card to keep score during the round and then compare the cards at the end of the round. After comparing recorded scores, the official card should be signed by both teams and turned into the bartender. *If the Women's League Cards are not setting out at the check-in book, they are in the cabinet below the book.*

### Best Shot League Scoring

There will be a total of 12 points available each week. The teams will be playing against each other for one point per hole. If there is a tie each team is awarded a 1/2 point. Finally, the team will figure their nine hole net score (Actual strokes, minus handicap) to tabulate a 9 hole net score. The lower 9 hole net score team wins 3 points. In the case of a tie each team is awarded a 1½ points. This is how we come to 12 points per match per week. **There will be a sample card available in the Ladies Locker Room for you to reference.**

**Teams that play Best Shot will have their handicaps calculated for them prior to their match being played that week.** Your best shot handicap will be posted each week prior to you playing your match. **Best Shot handicaps will be figured each week by adding up the nine hole scores and dividing that by the number of rounds played. We will then take that number and subtract it from the average course rating of 32.8. For instance, let's assume you played 3 rounds and shot 41, 38 and 42. Your average would be 40.3. You would need to take 40.3 and subtract 32.8 which equals 7.5. You would round that up to 8 and that would be your handicap for that week.**
