Message from Club President

I would like to welcome everyone back for another season of golf at the Indianola Country Club. It is refreshing to see the current COVID protocol has allowed the Club to return to more normal operating procedures. The board would like to thank our team for their dedication during this trying time and the members as well for their cooperation. With a little luck and many vaccinations, we will return to the new normal before the end of the summer. As you return, you will find many projects and improvements to the clubhouse and course that have been completed. We now have a more spacious patio to accommodate larger outdoor crowds and events. As the membership has grown so has the need to provide additional outside seating. I am happy to announce that food service will now be available on Friday and Saturday evenings starting May 1st. Please join us for an evening on the deck with your family and friends.

A portion of the driveway leading into the club is currently being replaced. As a board, we prioritize projects that fall under deferred maintenance. The driveway has deteriorated over the last several years with the last couple of winters accelerating the deterioration of the concrete. Thank you for your patience while this project is completed.

Joe and his team continue to enhance the appearance and playability of course through grubbing of trees and brush. His hard work and dedication is evident as the west nine continues to transform and improve our golfing experience.

We continue to explore the available options to reduce the impact of heavy rain events that create challenges on #10 green and fairway. We are working towards a feasible plan that will be implemented towards the end of this golf season.

The board continues to work with the City of Indianola and IMU on the new effluent water line that will be part of the sewer plant. As a reminder, water for the irrigation system is provided from the sewer plant. This effluent water is treated and is safe for purposes such as irrigation. When the new sewer plant is complete, we will be required to bury a new supply line that will run parallel with the new sewer truck line coming back to the city limits. This new line will ensure the Club has a consistent and more importantly an economical water source for the course. Without this effluent water line, the club would purchase fresh water from the City, which would be cost prohibitive.

As a reminder, the board meetings are open to the members and we encourage the participation of our members. This is the forum should you have any questions to concerns that you would like the board to consider or address. All decision made by the board are made after careful consideration as to the impact on the membership and financial stability of the club.

Again, I would like to thank our team. The pandemic presented all businesses with the numerous and unforeseen challenges. Our management team and staff handled this unprecedented and challenging operating environment well. The revised operating procedures allowed the Club to remain open with a record setting numbers of new members joining over the past year and higher than unusual amount of play on the course.

Thank you for your continued membership and support of the Indianola Country Club. Enjoy your summer and golf season.

Our club will be participating in PGA Junior League again in 2021. PGA Junior League is a way to introduce junior golfers to a team aspect of golf. We, the PGA, want to introduce a team aspect of the game to junior golfers. There are plenty of events for junior golfers competing as an individual who like and want stroke play events. However, every child enjoys the team aspect of sports. This program allows us to introduce competition to our junior membership in a fun and non-stressful environment. We will be part of the Des Moines area league and more than likely be in a division with three other teams. When our team hosts or travels the matches will consist of a total of 9 holes. The nine holes will consist of three three hole tournaments for a total of 3 points per nine holes. When we host or travel we will need a minimum of eight players as there will be four nine hole matches for a total of 12 points. Everyone who is part of PGA Junior League may travel so more than eight participating is great! When this occurs, we will sub in a player after a 3 hole match and every junior is guaranteed 6 holes. 
