How to calculate/estimate the electric charge on your bill:

1. Read your electric meter. Subtract the previous bill's reading from the reading shown on your meter. You can use this current usage to estimate your bill.

Your last billing statement shows the "Reading Date" and the "Reading", so you know when to read and what to subtract.

2. Enter the Minimum Residential Customer Charge
