Residential Services

The Camrose Women's Shelter Society is a 22-bed facility and provides emergency safe shelter for women and children fleeing family violence, or who are homeless due to crisis situations.

SERVICES INCLUDE:

- 24/7 Crisis Line available for referrals, assessments, and supported counseling
- Basic needs and donations
- Referrals to community agencies
- Advocacy
- Life skills groups
- Information on family violence and its effect on each family member
- Safety planning and Danger Assessments
- Outreach Program referrals
- Wheelchair accessible

Family Support Program

Family Support Program staff liaise with community agencies to meet the specific needs of each child, mother, or family unit and assist in transition planning.

GROUP AND INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS INCLUDE:

- Parenting
- Effects of family violence on children
- Positive role model for mother-child relationship
- Self-care needs
- Grades 1 to 12 School (funded by Battle River School Division)
- Children's Therapist for children settling in the Camrose community

ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN INCLUDE:

- Preschool learning
- Crafts and literacy
- Haircuts
- Yoga
- Field trips
- Visits from a local therapeutic service dog

In-house daycare is provided for residents by certified child care staff.

Outreach Program

The Outreach Program provides support for women and families in Camrose and surrounding communities, including:

- Confidential one-on-one support
- Personal safety planning and referrals
- Transition from shelter to community
- Advocacy
- Weekly support groups on family violence
- Needs-based transportation
- Community and school presentations on the impact and understanding of family violence
- In-home support for children who have experienced or witnessed family violence
- Community support group for women who do not wish to stay in the shelter.
