Keith will check the permits that were issued to Mr. Doddo's neighbor for the accessory structures that Mr. Doddo is questioning. Jack Varaly stated that although he has not received any paper work he did receive a phone call from Mrs. Ripp's attorney and she would like to have the zoning changed from commercial to residential where the Haven Restaurant is.

**ROAD REPORT** – John Doddo stated that Jarick Construction is doing a good job of plowing in Ramblewood.

**FIRE REPORT** – Bill Bauersfeld reported 8 calls during the month of December.

**NEWSLETTER** – Bill Bauserfeld stated that over the past few months he has been talking about a yearly newsletter being sent out and he stated he will volunteer to write it. The post office has a mailing program called EDDM (Every Door Direct Mail) and it will cost 17 ½ cents to mail the newsletter plus the cost of printing. The supervisors gave Bill approval to proceed.
