## **GRADUATION ELIGIBILITY**

1. Student must have been homeschooled his/her entire senior year. (Either a notice of intent has been filed or the family has filed under religious exemption). Parents are considered principal/teacher by state law.
2. Student cannot have been enrolled in any school during the 2021-2022 school year, with the exception of a dual enrollment program at a participating college.
3. Student and one parent must attend the three **Required Graduation Meetings:**
  - 1) **December 7, 2021 or January 11, 2022- Orientation**
  - 2) **April 29, 2022 – Cap/Gown Pick Up**
  - 3) **June 3, 2022 - Rehearsal**
4. Student must submit application, notarized affidavit, graduation fee, and order forms by **January 11, 2022**. In addition, photos and bios are due by **April 1, 2022**.
5. Student must behave in a respectful manner at all meetings, rehearsal and graduation ceremony.  
T.E.A.C.H. reserves the right to prohibit participation in Graduation if any behavior or dress is deemed inappropriate.
6. Outstanding debts to TEACH / BEACH must be met before eligibility is granted to attend the graduation.
7. **Refunds will be given up to two weeks after attended orientation meeting.**
