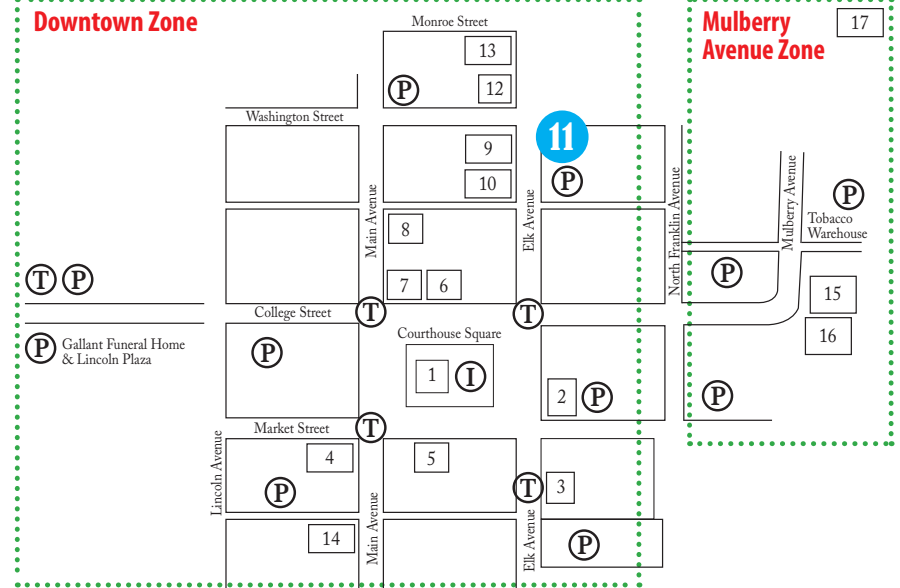

Downtown Zone



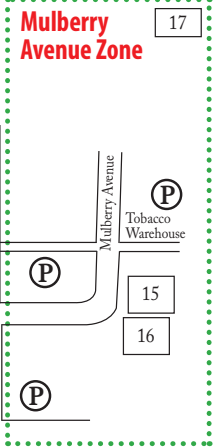
