Our speaks today will be Dr. Martha Hatala and Apostle Dr. Emmanuel Fiagbedzi.

Dr. Hatala is a native of DeKalb County, Ala., the mother of five children and the grandmother of 10. She graduated from Cleveland Chiropractic College in 1977 and practiced chiropractic for 40 years.

A member of the Boaz Rotary Club for 12 years, she was the 2015 recipient of Rotary International's Top 100 Women of Global Service nomination. She has served as chairperson of the club's International Projects Committee for seven years.

Pastor Emmanuel is general overseer of The Kings Voice Ministries International and has served in the Kingdom of God for over 20 years. He received his Diploma from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary, Ghana, his Masters of Science in Christian Education from Elle Ministries in the United Kingdom and a Doctorate of Divinity in Theology from Life Christian University in Tampa, Fla.

He and his wife Mercy are blessed with four lovely daughters, Emmanuella, Faithful, Grace and Glory.

In addition to pastoring his own church, Evident Life, Pastor Emmanuel oversees multiple churches, two schools and the satellite branch for Life Christian University. For the last four years, he has served as the administrator and facilitator for multiple projects sponsored by Rotary clubs locally and worked with Boaz Rotary and Rotary of Ho Ghana to implement a large region-wide water project in the Volta Region of Ghana. Collectively, he has assisted Rotary in providing 31 water stations and construction of a school and bath facilities. Pastor Emmanuel is an Honorary Rotarian.
