There has been some confusion regarding the status of S. Glenview Ave. in town. The utilities in the area are currently being replaced and upgraded to insure reliability and capacity in the city's utility infrastructure. We are trying to maintain as much as possible of the normal traffic flow in the area but there will be disruptions to the normal traffic flow while work is taking place. We are asking that motorists that are through traffic on S. Glenview Ave. take an alternate route to reach their destination. Anyone who lives within the work zone will be allowed access to their properties. Local deliveries to those residents along with garbage pick up and emergency services will be maintained while work is taking place. If access to anyone's property will be restricted, 24 hrs. notice will be given to that property owner whenever possible. We ask that you keep traffic in the work zone to a minimum while work is taking place for the safety of the workers in the area.

A "Road Closed to Thru Traffic" sign means that drivers cannot use the road to travel through to another destination; they must follow the designated detour or find an alternate route. However, residents, local businesses, and delivery drivers are allowed to enter the road to reach a location within the closed section. Key points to remember:

- **Do not pass through:** The sign prohibits using the road as a shortcut between other streets.
- **Local access is permitted:** You can still use the road if your destination is on that street, such as if you live there, work there, or are making a delivery.
- **Safety is the reason:** These closures are often in place due to construction, road work, or hazardous conditions to keep both the public and work crews safe.
