RESOLUTION TO EXCEED REVENUE CAP COMMENCING WITH THE 2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR
<p>BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Brillion Public School District, Calumet, Manitowoc and Brown Counties, Wisconsin, that the final school district budget shall include the amounts set forth below in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes each year for a period of three years on a non-recurring basis for the purpose of supporting the costs of maintaining current programs and services including costs of staffing, technology, educational programming, utilities, transportation and insurance as follows: \$815,000 for the 2023-24 school year, \$1,535,000 for the 2024-25 school year and \$2,030,000 for the 2025-26 school year.</p> <p>Question: "Shall the School Board of the Brillion Public School District be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 121.91 of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2023-24 school year on a non-recurring basis over a period of three years by the amounts set forth below for the purpose of supporting the costs of maintaining current programs and services including costs of staffing, technology, educational programming, utilities, transportation and insurance as follows: \$815,000 for the 2023-24 school year, \$1,535,000 for the 2024-25 school year and \$2,030,000 for the 2025-26 school year as provided in the foregoing resolution?"</p>
