

Hey, Folks,





What We Need:





- Cotton washcloths (The thinner ones are better than heavy ones—colors better than white)
 - Soap (small, hotel size)
 - Grosgrain ribbon 5/8" wide pretty colors
 - Thread (polyester, darker colors, regular & serger)



Fabrics* needed:

- 100% cotton
 flannel for liners
- 100% cotton calico or quilting fabric for shields
- Blend fabrics are OK for bags

*Fabrics should be bright colorful cheerful busy patterns to hide stains. Avoid animal, people, cartoon, pop culture, camouflage, or food patterns. Ideal fabrics are floral or geometric designs in darker or bright colors.
