

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING INFORMATION

The Garbage and Recycling Center is at 13775 County Hwy H; next to Town Hall. Its hours of operation are 8:30A.M. to 12:30P.M., Saturdays only. Garbage bag stickers are available for purchase at the site. **ALL BAGS CONTAINING GARBAGE MUST HAVE A BAG STICKER ON IT; AND MUST GO IN THE GARBAGE DUMPSTERS. (Persons placing garbage in the recycling dumpsters may be charged with littering, with fines up to \$300; likewise any person leaving garbage or recycling items at the center when it is not open can also be charged with littering, with fines up to \$300).**

The following items may be recycled:

Aluminum - food and beverage cans, such as soup, pet food, soda and beer cans, pie plates and foil.

Not accepted - wire.

Cardboard - Cardboard and shipping cartons, cereal boxes, roll core from paper products, etc. Cardboard boxes **must** be flattened.

Glass - Food and beverage bottles and jars, soda, beer, wine and liquor bottles.

Not accepted - mirrors, ceramics, porcelain, clay flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, drinking glasses.

Metal Food and Beverage Containers (Tin or Steel Cans) - Soup and food, pet food, **empty** aerosol cans, **empty** paint cans.

Not accepted - scrap metal such as toasters, pots, frying pans, coat hangers (must hold for clean-up day).

Papers, Newspapers, Magazines and Catalogs - Junk mail, paper grocery bags, phone books, paper egg cartons, paper milk and juice cartons (crush), office paper and shredded paper (in bags). Newspapers, magazines and catalogs should be bundled and tied with string, or in a box.

Plastic - (must have recycling symbol 1-7) - Empty plastic bottles with neck, including water & soda bottles, milk jugs, and personal care products. Quart and gallon jugs should be flattened. Plastic dairy tubs and deli containers need to be empty and lids removed. Plastic clamshells and berry containers likewise need to be empty.

STYROFOAM IS NOT RECYCLABLE; IT MUST BE BAGGED AND PLACED IN THE GARBAGE DUMPSTERS.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CANNOT BE RECYCLED, NOR PLACED IN THE GARBAGE DUMPSTERS:

Grass and Leaves, wood products, plumbing or building items, motor oil, chemical containers, upholstered items.

Microwaves, t.v.'s, computers, and other electronic equipment must be held until the County Electronics Clean-up day (normally held on the last Saturday in April; will be advertised).

Stoves, refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers and other household appliances are accepted during the Township Clean-up Day (normally held around the first Saturday of May). Tires, furniture, and some household appliances are accepted during the fall Clean-up Day (normally the first Saturday in November) if one is scheduled.
