

LIABILITY/RESPONSIBILITY WAIVER
(THIS MUST BE SIGNED TO COMPLETE REGISTRATION)
Amateur Athletic Waiver and Release of Liability

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the 2025 North Carolina Senior Games, State Finals program, and related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. The risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury to me does exist; and,
2. **I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS**, both known and unknown, **EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES** or other, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my readiness for participation and/or in the program itself, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, **HEREBY RELEASE** the North Carolina Senior Games, Inc., its officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("Releasees") **WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH**, or loss or damage to person or property incident to my involvement or participation in these programs, **WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OTHERWISE**, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
5. I, for myself and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, **HEREBY INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** all the above releases from any and all liabilities incident to my involvement or participation in the programs, **EVEN IF ARISING FROM THEIR NEGLIGENCE**, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
6. I also understand that it is my responsibility to check with my local Senior Games Coordinator immediately following my local Senior Games to determine if I have qualified for State Finals and to get a State Finals entry packet if I do not have internet access. My State Finals registration with payment and all required items must be received in the NCSG office in Raleigh by 11:59 pm on August 1, 2025. I understand the deadline is strictly enforced in fairness to all and it is my responsibility to make sure I am registered. I understand that if I do not send payment with my application for State Senior Games, the NCSG office will not process my application and I will not be allowed to compete.

7. It is also my understanding that I must be a resident of North Carolina for a minimum of three (3) consecutive months to participate in the Cleveland County Senior Games and the NC Senior Games. I do attest that I am either a year-long resident or I lived in North Carolina during the following consecutive months: _____
8. I hereby grant the Council on Aging/Neal Senior Center, its directors, officers, employees, agents and designees (collectively COA) non-revocable permission to capture my image and likeness in photographs, video, motion pictures, recordings, or any other media. I acknowledge that the COA will own such image(s) and further grant the COA permission to copyright, display, publish, distribute, use, print, and without limitation, publications, advertisement, brochures, website image(s) or other electronic displays and transmissions thereof. I further waive any right to inspect or approve the use of the image by the Council on Aging/Neal Senior Center prior to its use.
9. **I also understand that any outburst of anger, derogatory remarks, insults of any kind, inappropriate behavior, foul language, abuse or misuse of Senior Games equipment or any facility, or disrespect toward the Local Coordinators, students, or Event Director will result in immediate disqualification per the North Carolina State Senior Games Official Rule Book, Item #8. This type of behavior will not be tolerated by Cleveland County Senior Games..**
10. The safety and sportsmanlike conduct of everyone is of paramount concern. Senior Games Officials have the authority to disqualify and/or remove from current and future NCSG programs, anyone who exhibits inappropriate behavior or a condition of medical concern. Falsifying information in the registration process will not be permitted and may result in disqualification from current and future Senior Games activities.
11. **I also understand that there is the likelihood that I may be exposed to COVID-19 at any time during the games. I agree to follow directions outlined for protecting myself and others. I am participating in the events at my own risk and I will NOT hold NCSG, the Neal Senior Center, its sponsors or any playing areas responsible if I contract the COVID-19 virus.**

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT. I UNDERSTAND AND CONSENT TO HAVE MY MEDICAL INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO MEDICAL PROVIDERS DURING THE GAMES.
