Sharing their talent in musical theater, acting and improvisation, percussion, music, dance and movement, participants from Pocono Mountain East, Pocono Mountain West, Notre Dame, Francis Scott Key, Scranton Prep, Lehigh Valley Arts, Stroudsburg and East Stroudsburg North and South High School enjoyed the two week camp filled with fun, friendship and anticipation leading to their August 6 Camp Showcase performance at East Stroudsburg University.

Inspired by the experience, Mary Bolan beamed, "Music is definitely in my future!" The Pocono Mountain East junior admitted intimidation beforehand over the thought of working with Broadway professionals. As the upbeat festive environment ignited confidence from day one, a "welcoming" feeling took over for the teen.

Calling the daily drop-off "a great opportunity to better atune skills," mom, Lynda agreed it was a wonderful time for her daughter.

Considering the camp a great fit as "the perfect marriage of production, managing, and conducting for me," Festival artistic director Joey Chancey explained the benefit to those contemplating a career in the industry. "The point is to give a very broad taste of the performing arts to these young performers."

While some may move on to musical futures including Bolan with sights set on musical therapy, music education or the theater, "Preparing a generation of people to feel love and appreciate the arts," is for Chancey a great accomplishment in and of itself.

cellaneous cleanup finale November 14 to 18.

A reminder to rake leaves to road's edge with no bags or rigid containers was given followed by emphasis to avoid rocks, cans, bottles or other non-leafy items as not to damage equipment.

Approval was granted for a Pocono Farms Country Club Crime Watch request for \$250 toward purchasing magnetic signage for Crime Watch vehicles.

Supervisors agreed to pay bills totaling \$441,874.64, as follows: General Fund, \$310,893.60; Sewer Fund, \$2,974.01; Escrow Fund, \$107.03; and State Liquid Fuels Fund, \$127,900.00.

Supervisors Bill Weimer, Lynn Kelly, Alma Ruiz-Smith and Juan Adams were present; along with administrative assistant Erin Masker, controller Maureen Mills and an audience of approximately 15.

Coolbaugh's next meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. August 16 in the administrative building located on Municipal Drive in Tobyhanna.

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NOTICE OF 2016

PUBLIC DELINQUENT TAX SALE

To the owners of properties described in this notice, and to all persons or taxing authorities having such liens, tax judgements or municipal claims against such properties. In accordance with the provisions of the Act of 1947, P.L. 1368 and its amendments, known as the Real Estate Tax Sale Law, the following described properties will be offered by the Tax Claim Bureau of Monroe County, Pennsylvania at Public Sale for delinquent taxes at the Monroe County Administrative Offices, Stroudsburg, Monroe County, Pennsylvania on Wednesday, September 14, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. and continuing thereafter with adjournments and re-adjournments to such other days and times as may be announced at the sale or subsequently advertised. The purpose of said sale is to dispose of such properties against which delinquent taxes remain unpaid, the claims having become absolute, and legal period of discharge of claim expiring on January 1, 2015. The Terms of said sale shall be as follows: No sale of any property shall be made unless a bid equal to the final upset price is made. The approximate upset price is hereinafter set out after the description of each property and includes all taxes, penalties, returning fees, interest and costs as recorded in the Tax Claim Bureau and the approximate cost of this sale pro-rated. The final upset price will be announced at the time of sale.

The purchaser of any property shall, as soon as the property is struck down, pay the entire purchase money to the Bureau. In case said amount is not paid, the sale shall be void and the property again put up for sale. Properties for which no adequate bid is received may be re-exposed to bidding at a later time during the sale or any adjournment thereof at the discretion of the auctioneer.

Any taxing districts having municipal claims against any property herein advertised shall certify the amount thereof to the Tax Claim Bureau before sale in order to include the same in the final upset price. The sale of any property herein advertised may, at the option of the Tax Claim Bureau, be stayed if the owner thereof, or any lien creditor of the owner, on or before the date of sale, enters into an approved agreement with the Tax Claim Bureau to pay the taxes in installments, in the manner provided by the Act of Assembly, and the agreement entered into.

The Real Estate Tax Sale Law provides: There shall be no period of redemption after such sale. Every such sale shall convey title to the property under and subject to the lien of every recorded obligation, claim lien, estate, mortgage, ground rent and Commonwealth tax lien not included in the upset price with which said property may have or shall become charged or for which it may become liable.

It is strongly urged the prospective purchaser have examinations made of the title to any tracts in which they may be interested. Every reasonable effort has been made to keep these proceedings free from error. However, in every case, the property is offered for sale by the Tax Claim Bureau without any guarantee or warranty whatever, either as to existence, correctness of ownership, size boundaries, locations, structures or lack of structures upon the land liens, title or any other matter or thing whatever. No adjustments will be made after the property is struck down.

In vivid color, the memories of

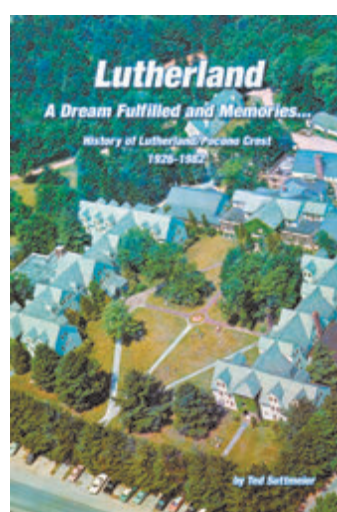

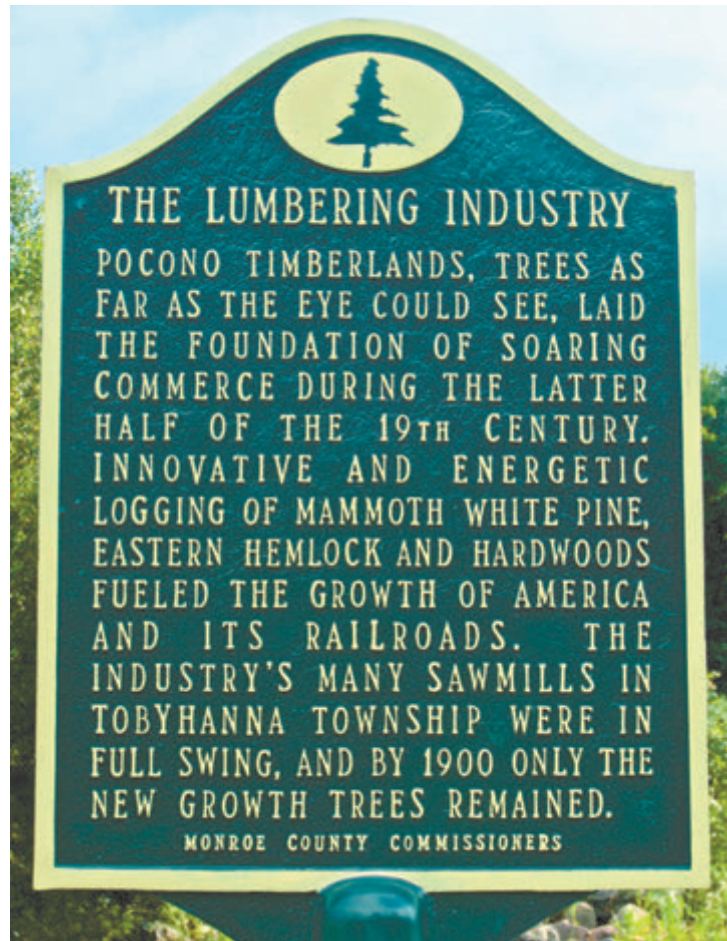

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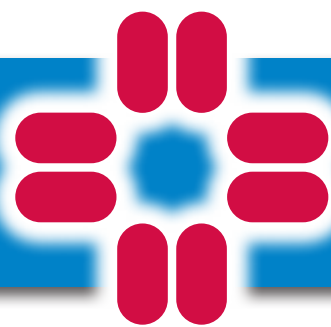


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
