Tuition is DUE the 1st of the Month. An automatic late fee of \$15.00 is applied on the 10th of the Month. Students with an account behind 1 month will be held out of class until all balances are paid to date.

TUITION: DUE 1ST OF

- A \$50 per student registration fee is due at the time of your child's registration.
- One dress code leotard **OR** shirt (for hip hop) is included with your registration fee.
- The first month's tuition (covering 1/2 of Aug. and 1/2 June tuition) is due at the time of registration/prior to 1st class.
- Studio offered discounts do not apply to registration fees **OR ANY** expenses for items.
- True Crew Dance Company offers sibling discounts, police, fire, teacher and active military discounts (proof required).
- Tuition is due on or before the 1st of each month September through May. Should you wish to pay your yearly tuition upfront, you will receive a 5% discount on your
- Tuition is based on the hours of instruction time for the season AUGUST THROUGH JUNE, NOT the number of MONTHLY classes.
- After the 10th of the month, late payments will be assessed a non-refundable \$15.00 late fee. This is automatically placed on the bill by the billing company and cannot be adjusted or removed once placed on the account.
- Payments by check must include child's first and last name, and payment details. When paying by cash, please use the Studio envelopes and fill out your students information.
- Payments may be placed in the locked payment box in the studio or can be submitted at the front desk.
- A \$30.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
- Credit card payments are also accepted in the studio and on-line through our website, truecrew.org. ***A processing fee of \$5.00 per transaction will be applied to credit card payments.
- We also accept CashApp, Venmo and ApplePay. 772-708-6564
- Tuition is not pro-rated, refunded or credited for missed classes due to:
 - weather, holidays or personal or studio vacation closures.

Attendance is **EXPECTED & RECOMMENDED** at **ALL** Classes, Recreational Performances/Recitals.

- To reach full potential in class, a student must attend on a consistent basis.
- We expect weekly attendance from all of our students at True Crew Dance Company.
- Students should arrive ready, approx. 10 minutes prior to their scheduled class time. (***SINCE COVID/CDC accommodations are in place, WAITING ROOMS are CLOSED Students will be given hand sanitizer in order to enter. Students wishing to wear masks are responsible for their items.
- Students should use restroom prior to being called into class and will be reminded to wash hands.
- Students MUST wait QUIETLY to be called into class.
- If a student must miss a class, please notify the studio at 772-879-2739 or via email at truecrew.info@gmail.com.
- Poor class attendance may result in dismissal from performances at the discretion of the instructor.
- There are no credits or refunds for classes missed.
- If your child has a contagious illness or is injured, please keep them home until they are recovered.
- Students should rest until they can fully participate in class without risk of relapse or injury.
- Tardiness/Lateness affects the entire class.
- If LATE, students may only enter their class with the assistance of our Office Staff/Assistants.
- In the case of serious illness/injury that would require a student to miss more than a month of class:
 - Request for Tuition to be waived MUST BE in WRITING.
 - Tuition may be waived as determined by the True Crew Dance Company Director.
 - This is on on a case-by-case basis.
 - A Doctor's Certificate requiring same MUST accompany the request.

Dropped Classes

- No refunds or partial credit will be issued for dropped classes after the 10 of the month. If after the 10th of the month, you are required to pay your tuition for the entire month regardless of the reason for dropping.
- Class/es dropped after the 10th and not paid by the appropriate due date, still receive a LATE FEE.
- If dropping a class, YOU are RESPONSIBLE to notify us via email at truecrew.info@gmail.com
- Once WRITTEN notice is received, your child will be removed from that class list and our billing records.

Adding Classes

- We always welcome enrolled students to try other dance classes at the studio.
- We offer a free trial class for those students wishing to try another class.
- The student must arrange for the trial class through the studio operations manager at the front desk.
- Students wishing to add the class to their schedule must fill out a "CLASS ADD
- Any additional tuition associated with the class(es) will be due upon the addition of the class/es.
- New classes are prorated when added at the end of the month.

Remember, you are here to learn. **DROP OFF** Parents Expectations • If you have questions or concerns about your child's class or progress, please: & feel free to email, or set up a private conference with the studio director. **PICK UP** • I will call and make arrangements to speak or meet with you at a convenient time. **PROCEDURES** • Please do not discuss concerns with the instructor before, during, or after a class. • Please come INTO the studio to DROP OFF PRESCHOOL AND COMBO students ONLY. PICK UP FOR ALL STUDENTS IN AROUND THE BACK OF THE STUDIO THROUGH THE PICK UP LINE, WHICH CANNOT BEGIN LINE UP UNTIL 5 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE END OF CLASS. Check the website and social media apps regularly for updates. • When in the studio, be sure to look at the bulletin board. Make sure you have received any current information that may have been handed out. This is especially important at PERFORMANCE TIME. • Notify the front desk of any difficulties or situations that your child may have. Please call if your child is going to be absent or needs to leave early. Parent/Guardian who decide to wait while students are in class, may ONLY park in the DOUBLE PARKING LOT behind our building parallel to Macedo Blvd. behind our studio. ***NOT IN FRONT OF AND NOT IT THE EXIT DRIVEWAY BEHIND the Studio--Cars in these areas WILL BE TOWED AT YOUR PARKING LOT OWN EXPENSE. The parking lot is NOT a play area. Any student age 7 or below, MUST BE PERSONALLY BROUGHT TO FRONT STUDIO OFFICE DOOR and ALL STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP FROM THE STUDIO BACK EXIT DOORS. IN KEEPING WITH COVID/CDC accommodations, we will continue to keep our waiting rooms closed with the exception of enrolled students waiting for classes, parents **WAITING AREA** making payments, registrations or class changes. Viewing of classes is available through a private app that you need to download. (The waiting room is not a play area and it is **REQUIRED** that any students waiting for class be **SEATED QUIETLY**. Thank you for your cooperation Studio Area • Food and drink BEYOND WATER, are not permitted in the studios. • Absolutely NO street shoes are permitted on the dance floors. Dirt, dust and debris from street shoes can lead to falls and injuries and may harm dance floors. • Students are not to lean on or touch studio mirrors. • Students are not to hang or swing from barres; nor should clothes or towels be hung from the barres. The dance barres are for educational purposes only. • All teaching tools, props, visual aids, and sound equipment are property of True Crew Dance Company and should not be touched or used without permission of the instructor. Restrooms • Children must be potty trained or in pull-ups to participate in classes at True Crew. We ask parents to monitor, remind students, especially young ones, to use the restroom prior to class time. If a child needs to use the restroom during class time, students need only ask permission. Please help us in keeping the restrooms clean. STUDIO • Pre-school students will be escorted to restroom with assistant waiting outside the door. When parents are in the waiting room, they will be brought to their parents **POLICIES** assistance. Parent Pick-up/Drop-off Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from class on time. LATE PICK UP OF STUDENTS WILL RESULT IN A LATE PICK UP FEE OF \$10.00 FOR THE FIRST 10 MINUTES AFTER CLASS PICK UP HAS ENDED AND \$1.00 PER ADDITIONAL MINUTE AFTER THE FIRST 10 MINUTES. Student Arrival, Drop Off & Pick Up

- Students should arrive to the studio ready for class, approx. 10 minutes prior to their scheduled class time.
- Students will need to be dropped off at the FRONT entrance of the studio to be processed into the studio. <u>NO EARLIER</u> THAN 10 minutes prior to their class beginning.
- Parent/Guardian MUST WAIT to leave until student has entered the studio.
- Students will go through temperature taking at the Entrance Door and once cleared, will enter. They will then use hand sanitizer and will enter the class.
- If late, Students WILL NOT be permitted to enter class after the first 10 minutes of class starting, as not to be a distraction.
- Parent/Guardian who decide to wait while students are in class, may ONLY park in the DOUBLE PARKING LOT behind our building parallel to Macedo Blvd. behind our studio. ***NOT IN FRONT OF or in the EXIT DRIVEWAY BEHIND the Studio.--VEHICLES IN THESE AREAS WILL BE TOWED AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE.
