I am very pleased to have you as a **FULL SEASON CONTRACTED MEMBER** of our growing family! This Handbook will provide you with information detailing our Elite Company rules, policies, procedures, and more.

Coming off of a very different type of Season there are many changes necessary, so please make sure to read through everything before committing.

For hopeful new interested Company Elite Members, we have been the 2018 World Dance Champions, have competed at Worlds for over 5 years and our students hold numerous National, State, Regional Titles. In 2019, one of our students also received 2019 NATIONAL MR. NEXSTAR, and throughout 2020, 2021 and 2022 our students continued to win Titles of Mr. Dance America, Mr. Believe, Mr. Starbound, Miss Dance America, Premier Mr. Imagine Orlando, and Petite Miss Platinum Runner Up. Further, 9 True Crew alumni has received full and partial college scholarships and have continued teaching at True Crew. With every new Season, I have raised the "barre" and we will continue to do so again! Therefore, our programs at True Crew have been revamped and reorganized so it is **VERY IMPORTANT** that you take the time to review this Elite Competition Dance Team Handbook thoroughly and let me know if you have any questions. Each dancer and their parent or legal guardian will be required to sign the Elite Competition Agreement at the end of this Handbook and hand it in fully executed once they have committed to the team.

True Crew Dance Company promotes a positive environment for all dancers where we teach that if you can believe it, you can achieve it. The Elite Competition Team requires 1000% commitment from the studio, students, parents, and staff. I am always available for our families and works with dancers and parents regarding any questions or concerns that arise. Any issues or concerns will NOT be discussed during class time. Further, teachers are NOT to be approached and will not take time away from scheduled classes or remain after scheduled classes to discuss individual matters. All matters are to be addressed by me, the Artistic Director, and if necessary I will conference with any teacher(s).

- Solos begin with a Choreography Fee due of \$300.00 upon acceptance for in-studio choreographers. Outside choreographers are paid at their own rates. Classes will meet as scheduled to complete the choreography during the months of August and September. It is the choreographer's responsibility to have all choreography done by the first week in October unless otherwise discussed between Ms. Toni, the choreographer and the student's parent. Should there be any concerns, it is the PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CONTACT MS. TONI directly at truecrew.mstoni@gmail.com
- > Following the Choreography Fees, Regular monthly tuition for the Solos is \$95.00 per month --- beginning with the OCTOBER TUITION PAYMENT
- > The Director will meet with the Choreographers/Instructors following Auditions to compile a list of students that they wish to offer a solo/ semi/ duet / private small group slots to.
- > Students will be advised of the specific Genre they are being offered.
- > Once students confirm acceptance, the Director/Choreographer/instructor will advise the student(s) as to the **MUSIC** they have chosen or if the students will be granted the opportunity to share 3 requests.
- > All final decisions are made by Ms. Toni, the Director.
- > You are **REQUIRED** TO **BE <u>TAKING</u>** the weekly <u>LEVELED</u> <u>CLASS</u> in the Genre of the solo, unless other arrangements have been made with the Director for an additional SOLO time slot.
- All solos will be required to exchange phone numbers and emails. Should a solo student drop from their routine at any point during the season, they will still be responsible for any costs or expenses that the studio may have or may need to incur. Further, no refunds will be given for any reason.
- **❖** Missed session will not be rescheduled, refunded or prorated.--UNLESS A SUITABLE SCHEDULE SWITCH TIME CAN BE ARRANGED AS EXPLAINED BELOW.
- If the instructor has to cancel the session, it will be rescheduled.

- > Once students confirm acceptance, the Director/Choreographer/instructor will advise the student(s) as to the **MUSIC** They have chosen or if the students will be granted the opportunity to share 3 requests.
- ➤ All final decisions are made by Ms. Toni, the Director.
- > You are <u>REQUIRED</u> TO BE <u>TAKING</u> the weekly <u>LEVELED</u> <u>CLASS</u> in the Genre of the solo, unless other arrangements have been made with the Director for an additional time slot. All duet/trios will be required to exchange phone numbers and emails. Should a duet/trio student drop from the routine at any point during the season, the student dropping the routine will be responsible for any additional costs that their other partners may need to incur. Further, no refunds will be given for any reason.
- Missed session will not be rescheduled, refunded or prorated.
- If the instructor has to cancel the session, it will be rescheduled.
- If a scheduled absence is necessary:
 - Parents must contact another soloist/duet/semi/private small group and try to work out a schedule change

COMPETITION/ PERFORMANCE/ WORKSHOP INFORMATION RULES & ETIQUETTE

ACCOMMODATIONS/TRAVEL: (1) You will be advised of host hotels, locations etc. (2) You are to book your own reservations and be responsible for same, (3) You are responsible for supervision of your own child. Hotels are suggested not required, you may stay where you wish. We just try to stay together for team bonding activities.

ARRIVAL/CHECK IN & OUT AT COMPETITION:

- **Arrive** to the competition facility **2 hours prior to your 1ST scheduled routine**.
- ❖ Hair and costume fully completed, **BEFORE ARRIVING**. Do not be late.
- Often schedules are changed and dancers may be asked to dance earlier than scheduled.
- If you are coming to support earlier routines and getting ready at the competition in the dressing room: Arrive 2 ½ hours prior to your 1st scheduled routine.
- Sometimes schedules start early on Fri. or run late on Sun. You may need to leave early from work & school if the schedule requires.

STRETCH:

- All dancers are expected and REQUIRED to stretch and warm up prior to competition. They will have a STRETCH CAPTAIN and are to follow their directions.

- ***FRESH CUT FRUITS OR FRESH CUT VEGETABLES ARE GREAT FOR SNACKING....BOTH TASTY & CRUNCHY.
- 1. **Low Fat Greek Yogurt with Berries:** Greek yogurt is rich in protein, and adding berries provides antioxidants and flavor.
- 2. **Low Fat Cottage Cheese with Pineapple:** Cottage cheese is a great source of protein, and pineapple adds a sweet and tangy twist.
- 3. **Protein Smoothie:** Blend protein powder (whey, plant-based, or your choice) with water or low-fat milk, along with fruits and vegetables for added nutrients that are made fresh. If from a smoothie store and not made at home with your own WHOLE FOOD PRODUCTS you must be specific to use water or low fat milk and only fruits or vegetables.
- 4. **Hummus with Veggies:** Hummus is made from chickpeas and is a protein-packed dip. Enjoy it with carrot sticks, cucumber slices, or bell pepper strips.
 - 5. **Hard-Boiled Eggs:** Hard-boiled eggs are convenient and rich in protein.
- 6. **Turkey or Chicken Roll-Ups:** Roll up **lean deli turkey or chicken slices** with lettuce, tomato, and a touch of mustard for a low-calorie, high-protein snack.
- 7. **Edamame:** Steamed edamame (young soybeans) provides protein and can be seasoned with a sprinkle of salt or your favorite seasonings.
- 8. **Tuna or Salmon Salad:** A small serving of tuna or salmon salad made with Low-Fat Greek yogurt or Avocado Mash instead of mayonnaise is protein-packed and nutritious.
 - 9. **Protein Bars:** Opt for low-calorie protein bars with minimal added sugars and a good protein content.
 - 10. **Roasted Chickpeas:** Roasted chickpeas are crunchy and high in protein, making them a great on-the-go snack for athletes.
