Resolution: Establishment of Charges for the Maury County Emergency Communications District.

WHEREAS, the Maury County Emergency Communications District plays a crucial role in providing efficient emergency communication services to the residents of Maury County, Tennessee.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish charges for addressing and mapping services provided by the Maury County Emergency Communications District, in accordance with the provisions of the Tennessee Code Annotated 7-86-101; and 7-86-127.

WHEREAS, the establishment of charges will enable the Maury County Emergency Communications District to sustain and enhance its services to ensure the safety and well-being of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following charges are hereby established for the Maury County Emergency Communications District, effective March 1, 2024:

- 1. Individual Residential Addressing Fee:
 - \$200 for up to 10 individual addresses per development
 - Flat rate of \$2000 per phase for more than 10 addresses per development
- 2. Reserving a Street Name:
 - \$200 per request, pending approval of the street name. This reservation will sunset after 24 months should the development not move forward. Any fees paid will be forfeited. Any streets previously reserved that exceeds the 24-month time frame will sunset on December 31, 2024. Any fees collected for reserving a street name are not included in the calculation of the maximum cost for a subdivision phase. Any fees collected are non-refundable or applicable to any separate project.
- 3. Adding Subdivision Streets:
 - \$500 per street for up to 10 streets per phase
 - Flat rate of \$5000 per phase for additional streets
- 4. Maximum Developmental Cost of Subdivision Phase:
 - A maximum cost of \$7000 per subdivision phase will be assessed. (Not to include Reserved Street Name cost.)
- 5. Governmental agencies and chartered non-profit organizations are exempt from these charges but must still adhere to the process for addressing and street naming.

The Maury County Emergency Communications District shall have the authority to collect these charges in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds generated from these charges shall be dedicated to the improvement, maintenance, and enhancement of the addressing and mapping services provided by the Maury County Emergency Communications District.

This resolution shall take effect on March 1, 2024, and shall supersede any previous resolutions or provisions that may be inconsistent with the charges established herein.
