TEN ELEMENTS IN THE LORD'S PRAYER

1. **A Personal Relationship With God** - Our Father
2. **Faith** - Which Art In Heaven
3. **Worship** - Hallowed Be Thy Name.
4. **Expectation** - Thy Kingdom Come.
5. **Submission** - Thy Will Be Done in Earth As it is in Heaven.
6. **Petition** - Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread.
7. **Confession** - And Forgive Us Our Debts
8. **Compassion** - As We Forgive Our Debtors.
9. **Dependence** - And Lead Us Not Into Temptation, But Deliver Us From evil.
10. **Acknowledgment** - For Thine is the Kingdom, and the Power, and The Glory Forever.
