

## CHURCH ETIQUETTE



**Worship** is the time when the people of God comes before **HIS** presence as a community of faith. As such, it should be regarded with seriousness and sacredness. The list below will assist in helping you to prepare for the **blessings** received during and from the worship service.

**COME** on time and **COME** regularly.

**DRESS** as you are going to meet the Lord.

**BRING** your own Bible (**BYOB**).

**BEGIN** to worship before you get to church by praying to God and on the way to church.

**DO NOT WALK** unnecessarily, especially during the sermon, scripture reading, invitation, prayer, choir's singing and in general whenever someone is speaking.

**DO NOT WALK** onto the pulpit unless invited by the Pastor.

**DO NOT TALK** unnecessarily. It disturbs others and the sanctify of worship.

**DO NOT LEAVE** all the singing to the choir; life up your voices as well in praise during the congregational hymns.

**DO NOT LEAVE** before the Benediction. **This is the final blessing you will not want to miss.**

**DO NOT LEAVE the Lord in the Sanctuary when you depart. Take the name of JESUS with you and serve the community of CHRIST.**
