It's A Bright Future With BrightCourse

In May 2019 the Women First Pregnancy Center implemented a new program made available to us from Heritage House for our Earn While You Learn program. Little did we know then just how vital this new program would be in the spring of 2020 when the Covid Quarantine hit!!

Although I've been volunteering at Sav-A-Life Shelby as a Client Advocate on and off since 2007, I began leading the Earn While You Learn program about 9 years ago. At that time, and until May of 2019, our clients could only take advantage of the program if they could attend an in-office. hour-long class which we had twice a month. In addition to



doing a short Bible study, the class time consisted of showing a DVD with either pregnancy or parenting content. One downside to the DVD system was that everyone had to watch the same video no matter where they were in their pregnancy or the age of



their child. For example, a woman who joined the class in her 1st trimester would have to watch the DVD with 3rd trimester content because that's where we were in the rotation. The same would Bright happen with parenting. A woman might come in when her baby ourse was 9 months old but would have to watch a video about newborn milestones even though her child was past that point. Another downside of the DVD system was that many of the videos were

from the early 1990s which meant that the content and the quality were very outdated. Lastly, because we had to buy the physical DVD, we only owned the ones with content from pregnancy through 1 year old.


All that changed with our subscription to BrightCourse because of generous gifts from people like youl Since it's a streaming service, a young mom can watch up-to-date videos with evidence-based content from the comfort of her own home or in the breakroom at work. She will also receive the videos that are pertinent to her needs whether it be the stage of her pregnancy, the age of her child(ren) or her relationship status. Almost all the videos also have a spiritual aspect to them. It's such a flexible system and the lessons are accessible and real....Earn While You Learn.....Cont. on pg 2

There are over 150 video options from the following areas: Pregnancy/Birth, 1st year, Toddlerhood, Parenting, One Heart/Two Homes (Co-Parenting), Fatherhood, Positive Partnerships, Life Skills, Special Circumstances, and more!

Now each woman receives videos sent to her email that are geared toward her individual situation whether she's pregnant with her 1st, 2nd or 3rd child, married or single, has a strong support system or not. In addition to email, I also communicate with my EWYL ladies through FaceBook and Messenger.

This program works and has grown to over 100 participants because of your financial partnership. We are making strides in providing a foundation for abundantly living. I'm so thankful we have these online tools as new moms can learn and grow and earn points so they can be used for diapers and wipes at times it fits their schedule.

As one client said, "With these classes the closer to my due date that I get, the more prepared I feel for the arrival of my new baby." (Ashley) And another client said, "The Earn While You Learn program has meant a lot to me because I've learned about what to expect with having a child and getting to know the Bible more. This program is awesome!" (Quinnisha) That's just what Earn While You Learn is all about!
