

Lent 2025: "Changed by Grace" - Ash Wednesday March 5th through

Holy Week (end of April)

Lenten Question:

How does Father God transform us for Abundant Life now and unto Everlasting Life? **Lenten Answer:**

Father God graciously sends his Son, Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit to transform us from the inside out through the indwelling Christ and His redeeming work.

Lenten scriptures:

1 - Ezekiel 36:26 - Moreover, I [The Lord God] will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you, and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

2 - 2 Corinthians 3:18 - But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

(This is the Word of the Lord! Thanks be to God!)

Lenten book:

"Amazing Grace" - a book about God's gracious transformation of John Newton from earthly wretch to servant of Christ. Holy Spirit inspired Newton to write the famous hymn, "Amazing Grace".

Lenten Invitation:

Indeed, thanks be to God for God's Living Word transforming us by God's redeeming grace and Spirit.

Let's heed God's sobering Ash Wednesday declaration from scripture: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return!" (Genesis 3:19)

And let's, in accord with God's declaration, *gather in worship on Ash Wednesday, March* <u>5th and receive ashes on our forehead.</u> The ashes are imposed in the shape of a cross, indeed Christ Jesus's cross, reminding us that our most certain mortality (signified by the ashes) will receive immortality from God at the resurrection because of Christ's own cross and resurrection. At the 2nd Coming of Christ, Christ himself will usher in the resurrection of all the dead for the final judgment unto everlasting life. Those who have received, in faith, Christ Jesus himself and his saving work will hear God declare them holy and righteous because of Christ's righteousness and everlasting life put by God onto our accounts. Death is sure for each of us, but so also is God's promise of transformation to Abundant Life in this life and resurrection from the dead unto everlasting life and peace with God.

Trust and follow Jesus. He gives you power, love, and self-control.




