- 3** How do you know when God's Spirit is guiding you?
- 4** Pentecost celebrates different languages and cultures — God loves them all! Play a game in which one person in your family reads the word "Hello!" in different languages. (There are many books and online dictionaries to help with this.) Everyone else can guess what language is being used.

#### **Ear Spark**

Next time you hear the wind, think of it as God's Spirit blowing through the world.

### **For younger kids**

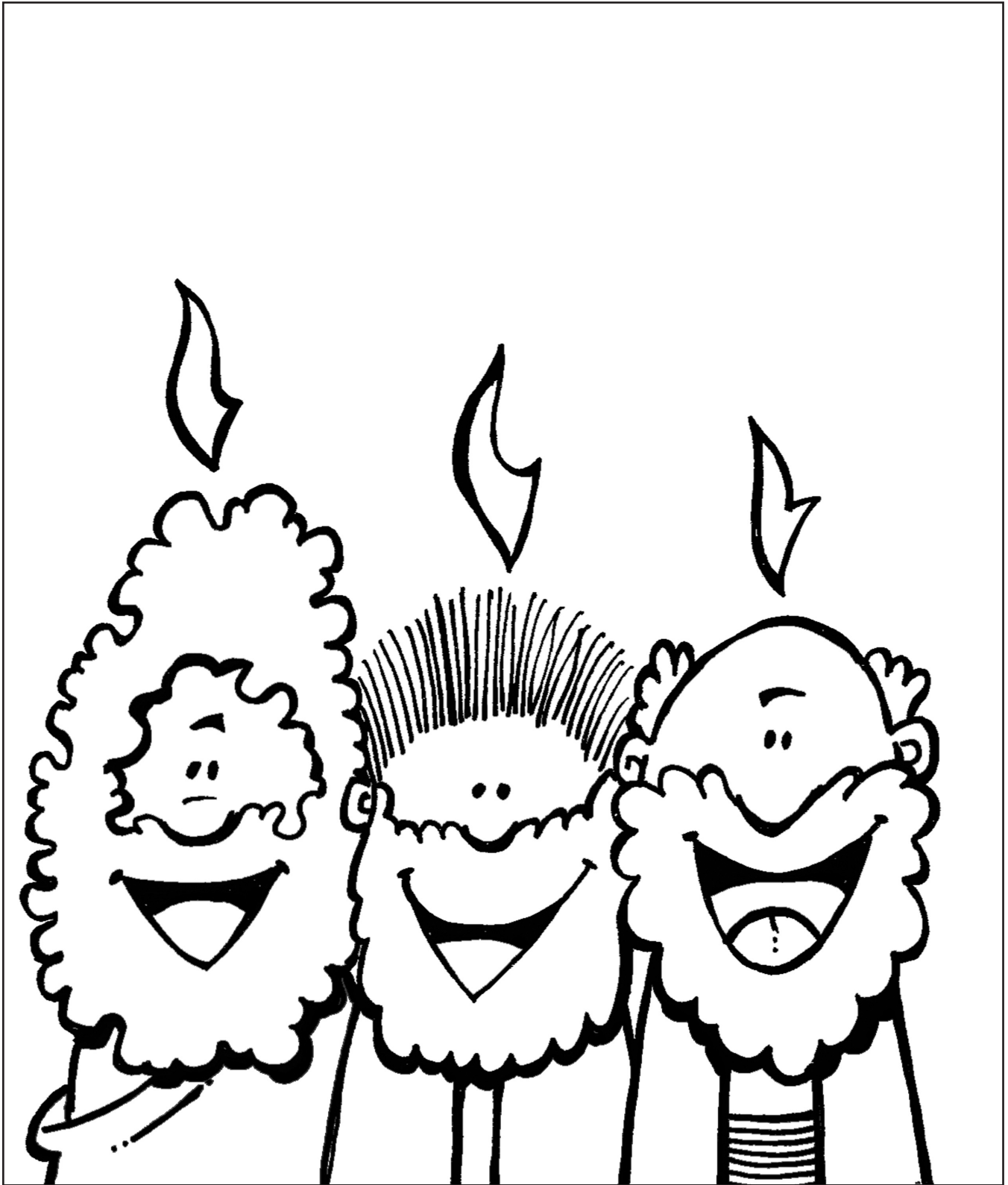
Wear red to help you remember God's Spirit is always with you!

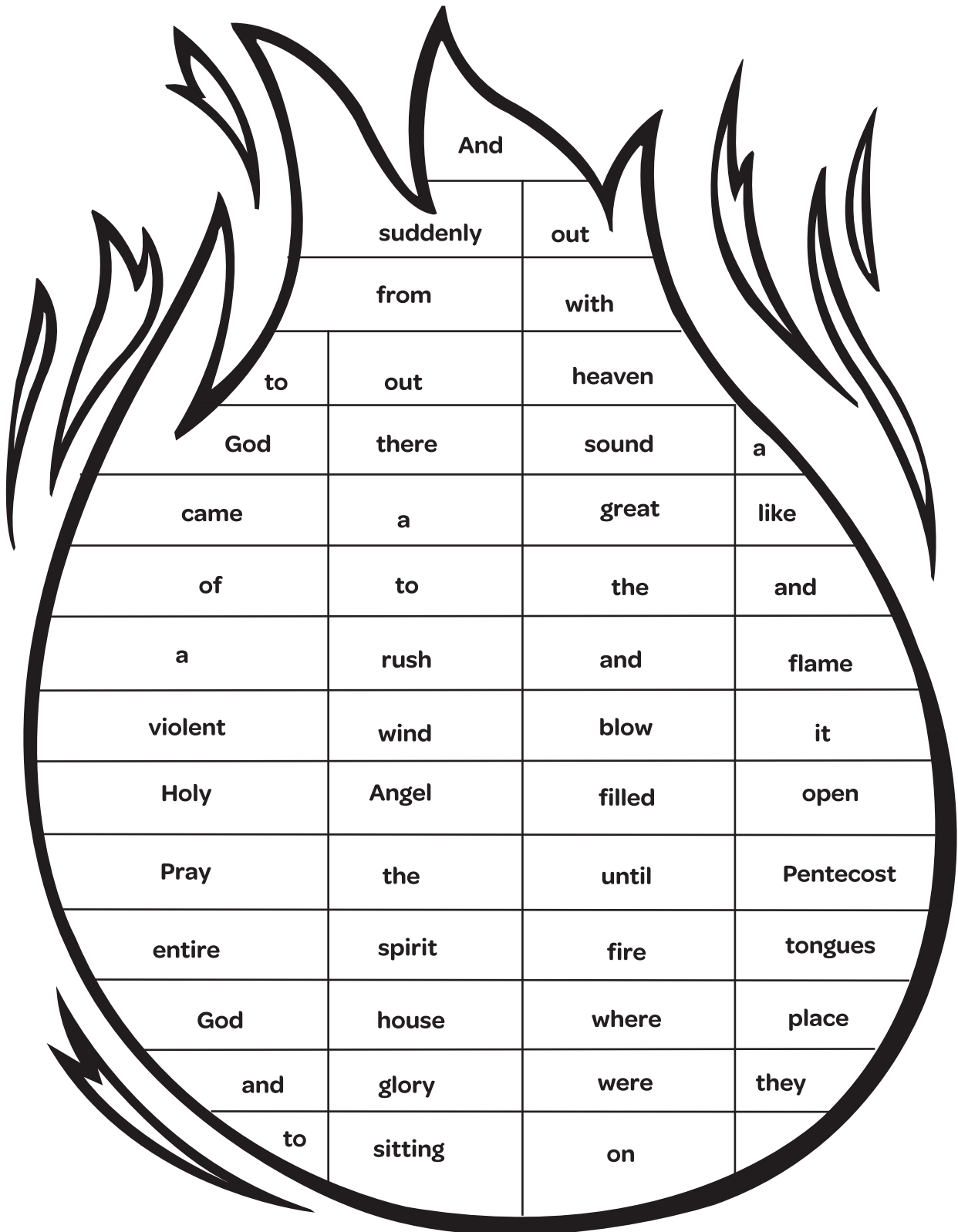
# Faithful Flames

It's the day of Pentecost! Draw a flame of fire over each disciple's head to show that the Holy Spirit is with him. Then color the whole picture.



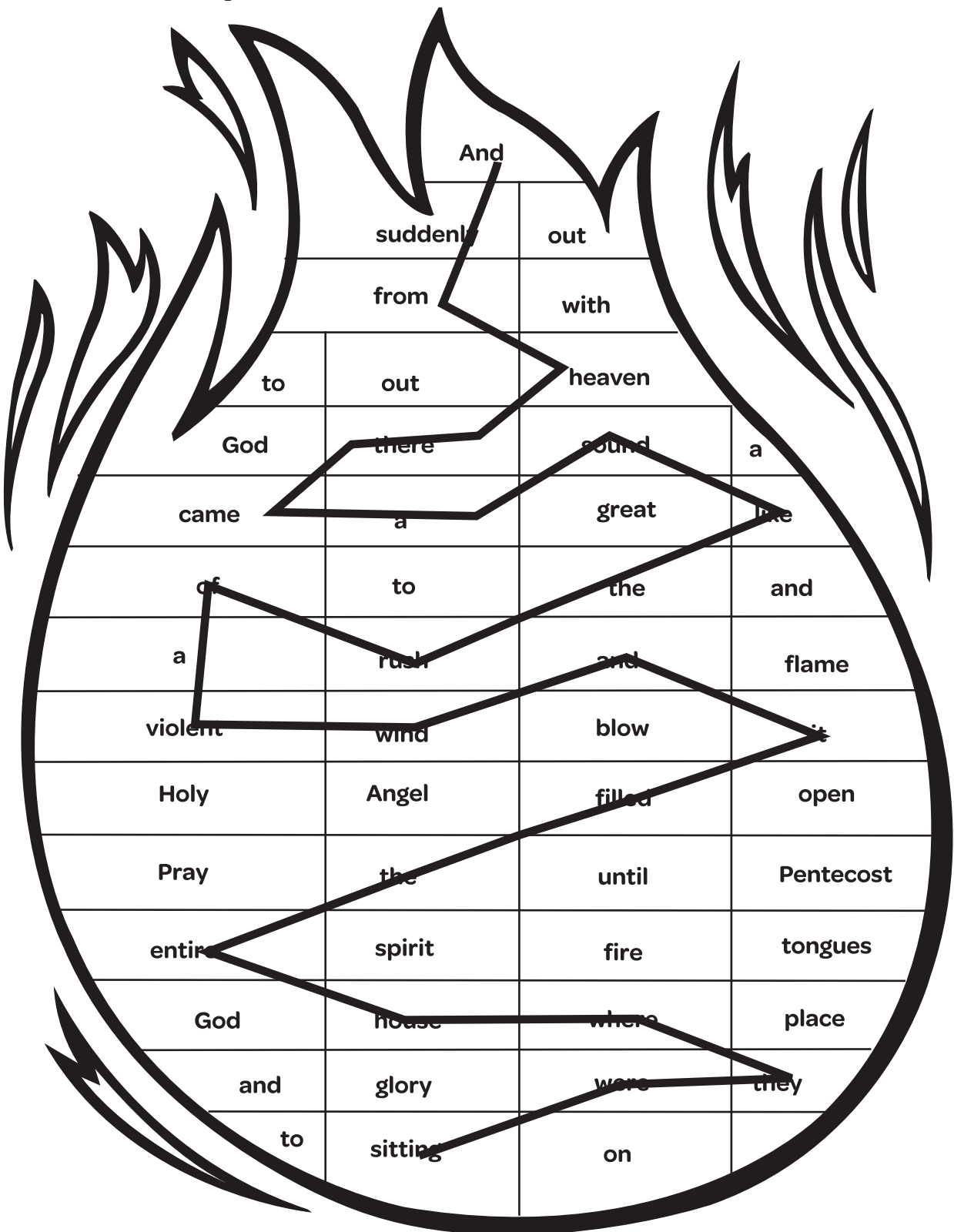
# Fire and Verses
