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SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Prince George's County Maryland Chapter (PGCMDC) of the Norfolk State University Alumni Association (NSUAA) Student Scholarship was established in 2002 for the purpose of aiding high school seniors and current Norfolk State University (NSU) students to pursue higher education at NSU. A book scholarship of \$250 will be offered to students who fully meet and maintain the eligibility requirements.

CRITERIA

- Any *State of Maryland* resident who is currently matriculating at NSU
- Demonstration of scholastic achievement (GPA 2.5 or higher) and motivation for higher education
- Exhibit qualities and traits of leadership, citizenship, and service to school and community

Guidelines for Applicants:

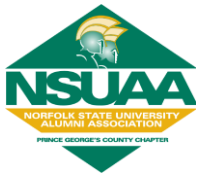
The scholarship recipient will be chosen by the PGCMDC Scholarship Committee. Members of the committee will review copies of the application to ensure that the application package is complete and all questions have been answered. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

Final selection for the scholarship recipient will be made by June 13, 2023. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the University, upon written verification of the student's academic requirements for NSU for the upcoming academic semester and official or unofficial transcripts.

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Instructions for completing this scholarship application:

Please read all scholarship requirements and directions carefully. Make sure that you are eligible before sending your application. Your application will not be considered if you do not meet the minimum qualifications or **if your application is incomplete.**

There is *ONLY* one part to complete for this scholarship application. Your application will be evaluated for grammar, spelling, content, and cohesiveness. You are strongly advised to have your materials reviewed and proofread prior to submitting your official application.

Questions

On a separate sheet of paper, please provide a brief, **typed** response for each of the following questions:

1. *Why did you choose to further your education at NSU?*
2. *Why do you believe that you are deserving of this Book scholarship?*
3. *Discuss your involvement in any volunteer, community or school-related activities. You may list any church affiliations or social organizations. Also include any special honors, awards, or achievements.*

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
