Continue with a word or two of **T**hanksgiving (such as how God has gotten you to this place and time, or for the use of the blessing/ability you are about to lose). Finally end the prayer with the **S**upplication or Petition for which you are asking (the need or blessing you seek from God), ending with an Amen.
