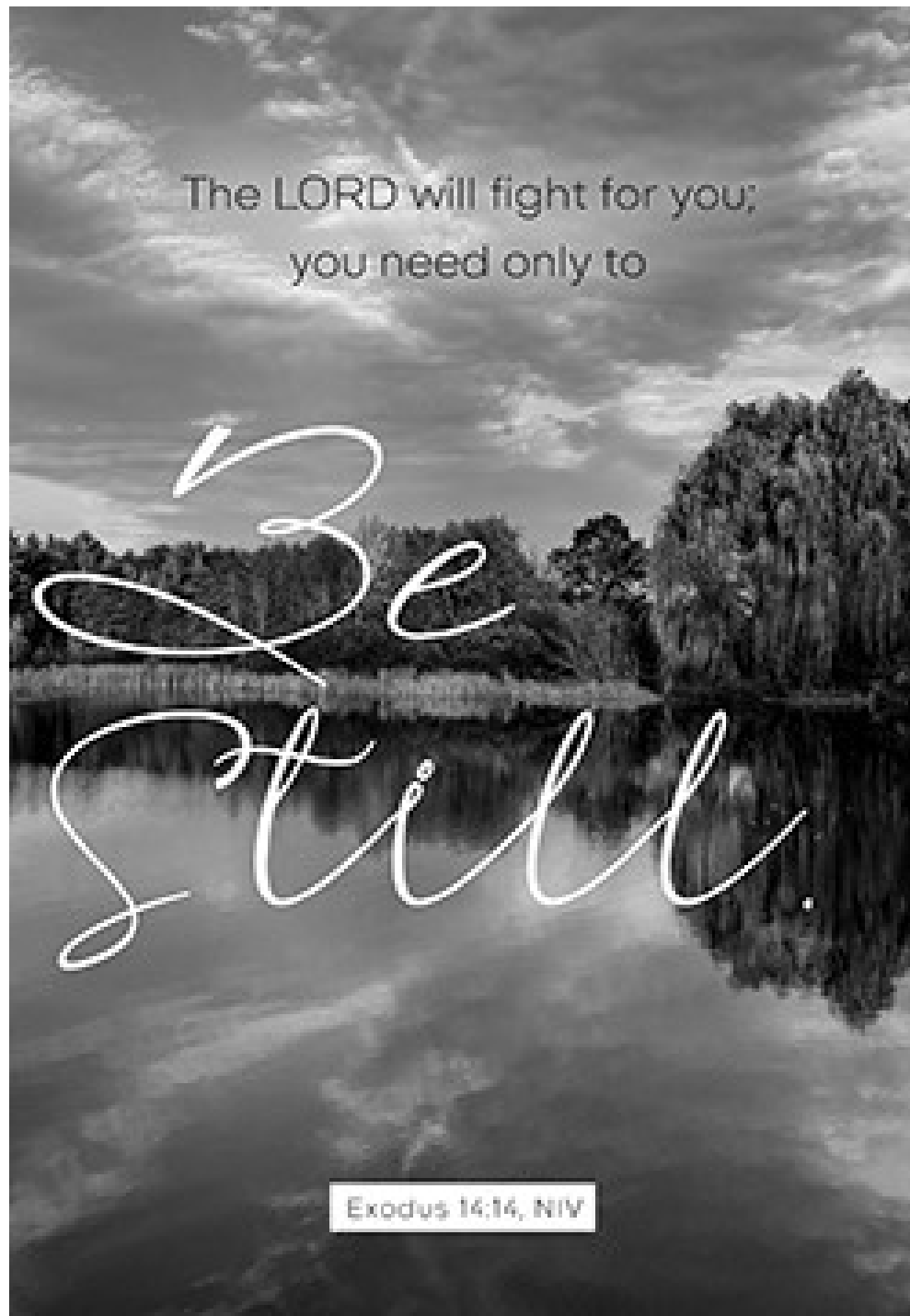

There is a fairly overlooked Biblical character in the Book of Acts, Barnabas. He shows up 3 times in Acts 4:36-37; Acts 9:26-27; Acts 11:21-26. He was very influential in spreading the good news about the gospel in the early church, and he was helpful to Paul. **His name means . . . “Son of encouragement.”** Every record of his behavior in scripture models what it means to be a loving, caring Christian. He was especially known for his service to others in the early church.
