Glue green pom poms to the green circle to make your wreath. Set the candles on the matching colors - 3 purple, 1 pink, 1 white. Each Sunday, read the scripture and reading for each candle. Burn the candles together as a family when you have meals together during the week.



Jesse Tree Ornaments Craft

Each day in Advent has an ornament representing someone in Jesus' family tree. The Jesse tree is the line of David. Each person is represented by a symbol. Put the symbol together and hang it on your tree or a separate place designated for the Jesse Tree. Learn about each person.



A Mason Jar Advent

Cut out and decorate your jar tags. Add them to your mason jar. Feel free to decorate your mason jar too. Your tags include the readings for each Sunday in advent (to go along with the candles on your wreath) and activities to help you prepare your heart in this season of Advent. Advent means "to come" thus we are preparing for the coming of Jesus.
