Review of the Petition for Annexation for the Hadley Elevator. Merlyn will present the Annexation to the Leeds Township board at their next meeting. Merlyn will get in touch with Judy LaBoda with the details of filing the petition.

Review of the minutes – approved.

Old Business:

- Insurance Claim- The pump repair could not be covered under the insurance as it was not a result of brown outs, but caused by corrosion, rust, decay etc. It was suggested that a filter be installed and additional water testing to be done to prevent such destruction to the equipment. The city should probably be visiting with Darwin Johnson from Slayton regarding this issue.
- Heating and A/C system – Parker has not contacted Rick about installing a new system; the hallway ceiling repair is not yet completed.
- Letter to the County regarding culverts – Rick will write and send a letter regarding cleaning out the culverts.
- Gravel to the lift – has not been delivered.
- Waiting on the state for confirmation of Hwy 30 construction to try and coordinate black top availability to make repairs to some of the city streets.
- Judy will send a certified letter to the resident that has garbage accumulation that is a health hazard.
- City Clean up? Should we send the same letter as last year? Yes....we should send a letter for the tree/brush pick up and burning in the water billing.
- Dale will look into the cost of a sign for the tree dump site to make it clear of the responsibilities of dumping on that site.
- Justin Lawson has been doing clean-up of the area behind Henry Veldhuisen's house and it's looking very good.
- Dale has suggested he would cost share with the City for the removal of the trees that are adjacent to his camp ground property. There has been conversation with Justin Lawson to bid on removing those trees.

New Business:

- There is water that is coming into the meter hole at the camp grounds. Where is the water coming from? Dale will research.

- Dale would like to have speed limit signs on his property. M/S/P by Nick and Henry to install a 20 MPH speed limit sign on Summit Lane.

M/S/P by Henry and Dale to pay bills.

M/S/P by Nick and Henry to adjourn meeting.
