

City of Hadley Council Meetings

14 November 2016

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Mayor Like.

Welcome the guests:

Jeff Van Buren from USDA – review the letter of condition and requirements of the contract and compliance.

Wayne Wee: Concerns about the water meter. A new water meter was installed a couple of weeks ago. If residents are having issues with the water flow, you need to contact the city with the issue. M/S/P by Dale and Bonnie to hire his plumber to install the meter in Wayne Wee's house. He will bring the billing to Judy to reimburse him for installation of the meter. He will monitor the meter to make sure that it is working correctly.

Review the minutes with one correction. Minutes approved.

Liquor fund: The fund is approved – the new ice machine is in and working. Myron talked with Hadley Steel about building and installing a stainless steel shelf for the microwave.

Proclamation by Mayor Like: Friday 25 November 2016 Hadley Buttermaker's Day.

General Fund: \$300 was donated by the Lions Club for The Richard Johnson memorial tree for the Tree of Lights.

Water/Sewer Fund: Approved

Old Business:

- Water issues – Need to schedule a time to set a meeting with Bob Wornson about flushing the system and making some changes to the pipe level. More residents are complaining about the water conditions. Some people are experiencing bad water. Deb Lee washed clothes and had rust stains on her white clothes after many showers, and clothes washing. The pick-up pipe needs to be raised and the mains need to be flushed.
- Budget- M/S/P by Henry and Bonnie to approve the 2017 Budget as presented.
- M/S/P by Dale and Nick to transfer \$3000 equally distributed to the Water and Sewer maintenance savings accounts.
- A/E/D check of the pads. The pads and batteries are due to be replaced.
- Ballpark Update – dugouts have been dug in and the cement has been poured. Gene Gustaf anticipates getting them fully blocked by the end of this week. Adam Tentinger has hooked up the water lines. Raffles tickets through the Lions Club and proceeds after prizes will go to the Ballpark. Nobles Coop Electric has donated \$1125 to the sidewalk and the ball park.

- Dale has spoken to the County Commissioners about the spill ways and the culverts and why they are not making the repairs. Who can we contact to get this work done? Dale will attend the next Commissioners meetings.

New Business:

- Who smashed the dock? It was very damaged and not repairable. We will turn the police report into the insurance company. Possibly we could use some of the money from the conservation saving fund to assist with a new dock.
- M/S/P by Henry and Nick to change the Council meeting time to 6 PM from December to March.
