Review of the October Minutes: Minutes approved

Review of the Liquor fund: The walk-in cooler is not cooling, an estimate from Sahlstrom's is \$2500+ and will also need to have an electrician wire some of it. M/S/P to repair the walk in cooler by Dale and Nick; the pool teams have started and 2 dart teams started; pinochle will start in a month or so. The liquor fund approved.

- Poles are completed. What about the transformers? Judy will contact Xcel about the pole that was the worst at Vicki Mahon's corner; across from Joyce Johnson's – that is leaning. Why were these not replaced?
- Rick spoke to the Slayton Fire department and they were not sure if they would be successful in accomplishing flushing the culvert at the end of the alley behind the Liquor store. They will get it completed this year.
- Justin's wood pile -----Rick has spoken to him about getting it cleaned up.
- No one has signed up yet for the Board Appeals & Equalization, You have until 1 February, 2018.
- Nick used his Pick-up to pull out the dock and it moved easily. The ramp and the dock have a hinge to allow it to flex.

- Wrapping the trees? Rick has purchased some deer repellent to put around the trees.
- Dale has spoken to several people to get someone to look at doing a concrete apron at the end of the alley behind the liquor store. No one has gotten back to him. We will have to wait until Spring for the apron to be poured.

New Business:

- We will post pone the final approval of the proposed budget for 2018 at the December meeting.
- M/S/P by Henry and Nick to change the start time of the Council meeting to 6:00 pm beginning in December to March.
- Dale asked if the council intercede to get the Lee's mailbox out of the street? Rick will talk to the Postmaster to see about getting it moved.
