Approve November Minutes: Approved with corrections

Judy will talk to Tony Sorenson at Hadley Steel to see if they would be able and have the correct tools to pour the cement apron at the South end of the alley.
- Bonnie spoke with Gordy Swan about using a snow blower on Summit Lane; and he's concerned about the wood in front of Justin Lawson's house.
